

## 2.12 2004-05 – Administrative Sanction for Construction and Maintenance

### ORDER

The Pradhan Mantri Gram Sadak Yojana is a centrally sponsored scheme introduced by Government of India from 01.04.2000 for achieving total connectivity in rural areas.

2. In the Government Orders first, second and third read above orders were issued for implementation of Pradhan Mantri Gram Sadak Yojana in this state. For the implementation of this scheme the State Level Standing Committee has to analyse and approve the list of roads proposed each year by the Districts from the core network. Accordingly, the State Level Standing Committee vetted the proposals for 2003-04 at an estimated cost of Rs.367.22 Crore.

3. After the approval State Level Standing Committee, the Detailed Project Report prepared by the District Rural Development Agencies were scrutinised and countersigned by State Technical Agency viz. Regional Engineering College, Trichirappalli. For 2003-04 Detailed Project Report to a tune of Rs. 327.90 Crore were countersigned by the State Technical Agency.

4. The countersigned Detailed Project Reports were forwarded to Government of India and the Empowered Committee of Ministry of Rural Development in the letter fourth read above allotted Rs. 164.785 Crore for 498 road works for the year 2003-04 as phase III and the Administrative Sanction and Maintenance cost of Rs. 4,67,84,640/- was accorded in the Government Order fifth read above.

5. A proposal for Rs.117.91 Crore was placed in the Empowered Committee of Ministry of Rural Development, Government of India as additional allotment for 2003-04. But in the letter 6<sup>th</sup> read above the Government of India have cleared the project proposals for an amount of 117.91 Crore covering 417 roads under Pradhan Mantri Gram Sadak Yojana for the year 2004-05 as Phase IV vide Annexure I of this order.

6. During the weekly review meeting under Pradhan Mantri Gram Sadak Yojana held at the Chamber of the Secretary to Government Rural Development Department on 03.08.2004, it was suggested that Administrative Sanction of works may be accorded by the competent authority. Accordingly the Director of Rural Development has requested the Government to accord Administrative Sanction for the 12 works out of 417 works the value of which is more than Rupees one Crore and indicated that Administrative Sanction may be accorded by Director of Rural Development / Collectors, for the works having value of more than Rs.25.00 Lakh and up to Rs.1.00 Crore/ Less than Rs.25.00 Lakh respectively.

7. As per the guidelines of Pradhan Mantri Gram Sadak Yojana, the cost for the routine maintenance for the road works executed under Pradhan Mantri Gram Sadak Yojana up to 5 years have to be borne by the State Government. The Director of Rural Development has therefore requested the Government to allocate Rs. 346.878 Lakh for the routine maintenance of all 417

road works to be executed under Pradhan Mantri Gram Sadak Yojana for 2004-05 as Phase IV.

8. The Government after careful consideration of the proposal, hereby accord necessary administrative sanction for an amount of Rs.1854.27 Lakh (Rupees eighteen Crore fifty four Lakh and twenty seven thousand only) for executing 82.270 Kms length of 12 road works in Tamil Nadu as detailed in Annexure II of this order and for the maintenance cost of Rs. 346.878 Lakh (Rupees three Crore forty six lakh eighty seven thousands and eight hundred only) to maintain all 417 road of length 825.900 Kms for a period of five years as detailed in Annexure III to this order.

9. The Director of Rural Development is directed to instruct the District Collectors to meet the maintenance cost mentioned in para 8 above from the State Finance Committee Grants to Panchayat Unions and the balance amount should be given as devolution to Panchayat Unions.

10. This order issues with the concurrence of Finance Department vide U.O.No.62609/RD/04 Dated: 21.09.2004.
