

**2.10 2003-04 - Administrative sanction of Rs.4,67,84,640/- for 5 years maintenance cost for PMGSY Roads to a length of 1113.92 Km**

**ORDER**

The Pradhan Mantri Gram Sadak Yojana is a centrally sponsored scheme introduced by Government of India from 01.04.2000 for achieving total connectivity in rural areas.

In the Government Orders 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> read above orders have been issued for implementation of the Pradhan Mantri Gram Sadak Yojana in the State. For the implementation of this scheme the State Level Standing Committee has to analyze and approve the list of roads proposed each year by the Districts from the Core network. Accordingly the State Level Standing Committee vetted the proposals for 2003-04 at an estimated cost of Rs. 367.22 Crore.

3. After the approval of State Level Standing Committee the Detailed Project Reports prepared by the District Rural Development Agencies have been scrutinized and countersigned by the State Technical Agency viz. Regional Engineering College, Trichirappalli. For 2003-04, Detailed Project Report to a tune of Rs. 327.90 crore, have been countersigned by the State Technical Agency.

4. The countersigned Detailed Project Reports were forwarded to Government of India and the Empowered Committee of Ministry of Rural Development in the letter 5<sup>th</sup> read above have cleared the same and have allotted an amount of Rs.164.785 Crore for 498 road works to be taken up under PMGSY for the year 2003-2004 (Phase-III)

5. The Government after careful consideration of the proposal, hereby accord necessary Administrative Sanction for an amount Rs. 164.785 Crore (Rupees one hundred and sixty four Crore seventy eight lakhs and fifty thousand only) for executing 1113.92 kms length of 498 road works in Tamil Nadu and their maintenance cost of Rs. 4,67,84,640/- (Rupees four crore sixty seven lakh eighty four thousands six hundred and forty only) for a period of five years as detailed in ANNEXURE -I to this order. The district wise package of road works are detailed in the ANNEXURE-II of this order.

6. The Director of Rural Development is directed to instruct the District Collectors to meet the maintenance cost mentioned in para 5 above from the State Finance Commission Grants to Panchayat Unions and the balance amount should be given as devolution to Panchayat Unions.
