ORDER

The Government of India had released a sum of Rs 65.84 Crores during 2005-06 as Central share of funds in the release orders 2 to 6 read above to the 6 districts of Tamil Nadu viz., Cuddalore, Villupuram, Dindigul, Tiruvannamalai, Nagapattinam and Sivaganga where Tamil Nadu Rural Employment Guarantee Scheme is being implemented . During 2006-07 the Government of India have released a sum of Rs.98.89 Crores as initial instalment in the release order 8th read above. As per norms 10% of the Central release has to be met by the State Government as State share for the implementation of the Scheme. The State Government in its order 7th read above released a sum of Rs.1.00 crore during 2005-06 as State share.

2. The Director of Rural Development and Panchayat Raj in his proposal 9th read above has requested to release a sum of Rs.17.30 Crores as proportionate State share for the Central share already released so far from the available provision of Rs.26.00 Crores in the Revised Budget Estimate for 2006-07 under Tamil Nadu Rural Employment Guarantee Scheme head of Account as follows:-

The Director of Rural Development and Panchayat Raj has stated that it is anticipated that Rs.402.78 crores is likely to be available from Government of India and therefore requested also to

allocate Rs.40.27 crores as State share and to provide additionally Rs.15.27 crores (Rs.40.27-25.00 crores already provided) in the First Supplementary Estimate 2006-07.

3. The Government after careful examination accept the proposal of the Director of Rural Development and Panchayat Raj and sanction is accorded for the release of Rs.17.30 Crores(Rupees Seventeen Crores and thirty lakhs only) being the proportionate State share for the Central share already released so far as indicated in para 2 above to meet the cost of payment of unemployment allowance, one fourth of the material cost of the Tamil Nadu Rural Employment Guarantee Scheme including payment of wages to skilled and semi-skilled workers subject to the provisions of schedule II of the National Rural Employment Guarantee Act 2005 and the administrative expenses of the Tamil Nadu State Employment Guarantee Council, during 2006-07.

4. The amount sanctioned in para 3 above shall be debited to the following head of accounts:-

(Receipts subsequent expenditure to be incurred under this scheme shall be debited in the service head of account to be opened and the same shall be adjusted by deducting under the - following head:)

State Plan - JA - Deduct - Amount met from the Tamil Nadu State Employment Guarantee Fund 30. Inter account transfer (DPC 2505 01 902 JA 3001) by contra debiting from "J. Reserve Funds - (b) Reserve Funds not bearing interest - 8229-00. Development and Welfare funds - 119 - Employment Guarantee Fund - I - Non - Plan - AB - Further expenditure met from the Tamil Nadu State Employment Guarantee Fund (DPC 8229-00-119 -AB-0006)

5. The additional fund required by the Director of Rural Development and Panchayat Raj of Rs.40.27 crores will be provided at the time of finalising the estimates for RE/FMA 2006-07 based on the Government of India releases. The Director of Rural Development and Panchayat Raj is requested to send the proposal to Government in the matter at an appropriate time after the receipt of Government of India share.

6. The Director of Rural Development and Panchayat Raj is authorised to draw the amount and disburse it to the districts concerned in accordance with the Central releases made.

7. This order issues with the concurrence of Finance Department vide its U.O.No.53226/Fin.(R.D.)/06 Dated 6.9.2006.
