The Director (CRSP) Government of India, Ministry of Rural Development, Department of Drinking Water Supply, New Delhi, in his letter first read above, has stated that as per existing practice, Government of India deputes review machine consisting of experts drown from Govt. of India, State Government, external agencies and Non Government Organisations as well as retired professional to the Total Sanitation Campaign projects to assess the quality of implementation of Total Sanitation Campaign Programme. Likewise it has been noticed that since scaling up of Total Sanitation Campaign has taken up considerably, it has been felt essential that similar review mission should be made at State Level and accordingly requested the State Government to constitute a State Level Review Mission.
