Sir,

I am directed to convey the sanction of the President of India for payment of grant-in-aid of Rs.1, 37,00,000(one crore thirty seven lakh only) under SGSY to the District Rural Development Agencies in the State of Tamil Nadu listed at Annexure-I, as final instalment of funds for conducting BPL Census, 2002.

2. The funds allocated to the districts are in proportion to the rural population in the districts as per 2001 census.

3. The BPL Census, 2002 under SGSY is 100% centrally funded subject to a ceiling of Rs.9/per rural household in the Northe Eastern States and Rs.6/- per rural household in the other States/UTs, assuming 5 persons per household.

4. The States/UTs may decide the expenditure to be borne on different activities for the successful completion of the BPL Census, including data processing for identification of the BPL households and also for building up the profile of rural households in a time bound manner.

5. The result of the Census and the complete data collected through the Census (on electronic medium), together with the details of expenditure may be furnished to this Ministry immediately.

6. The release of funds is subject to audit by internal audit of the Ministry of Rural Development

7. The amount is to be utilised for the BPL Census, 2002 as per the guidelines issued vide this Ministry's letter No.Q16025/4/2002-A1(RD)dated 13th September, 2002.

8. The expenditure is debitable to Deptt. Of Rural Development, Ministry of Rural Development under the head:

Demand No: 67, 2501-Special Programmes for Rural Development. (Major Head) 06.101 - Swarnjayanthi Gram Swarozgar Yojana: (Minor Head) 12 - Assistance to District Rural Development Agencies 12.00.31 - Grants-in-aid

9. Pay and Accounts Officer in the Ministry of Rural Development shall be the Drawing and Disbursing Officer for this purpose.
