

#### **ABSTRACT**

Schemes – Centrally Sponsored Scheme – Enhancement of Wage Rate from Rs.132/-to Rs.148/- under Mahatma Gandhi National Rural Employment Guarantee Scheme (MGNREGS) works by the Government of India – Adoption in Tamil Nadu – Revision of Rural Schedule of Rates – Orders – Issued.

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### **ORDER:**

In the Government order first read above, orders have been issued revising the wage rate from Rs.119/- to Rs.132/- per day per person for the unskilled manual workers under Mahatma Gandhi National Rural Employment Guarantee Scheme and the Rural Schedule of Rates has also been revised under Mahatma Gandhi National Rural Employment Guarantee Scheme for the unskilled manual workers in Tamil Nadu.

- 2. The Government of India, Ministry of Rural Development in the Gazette of India Notification second read above have notified the Wage Rate payable to the unskilled manual workers under Mahatma Gandhi National Rural Employment Guarantee Scheme in respect of all States. The Government of India have enhanced the Wage Rate from Rs.132/- to Rs.148/- per day per person payable for the unskilled manual workers under Mahatma Gandhi National Rural Employment Guarantee Scheme in respect of Tamil Nadu with effect from 01.04.2013. Accordingly, the same was announced in the Budget Speech 2013-14 rendered by the Hon'ble Finance Minister in Tamil Nadu Legislative Assembly on 21.3.3013.
- 3. The Commissioner of Rural Development and Panchayat Raj in his D.O. letter third read above has sent the proposal for the enhancement of wage rate from Rs.132/to Rs.148/- to the unskilled manual workers under Mahatma Gandhi National Rural Employment Guarantee Scheme and the revised Rural Schedule of Rates for the year 2013-14 for the wage rate of Rs.148/- per day per person to the unskilled manual

workers under Mahatma Gandhi National Rural Employment Guarantee Scheme with effect from 01.04.2013 and requested orders of the Government.

- 4. The Government after careful examination of the proposal of the Commissioner of Rural Development and Panchayat Raj have decided to accept the proposal and accordingly issue the following orders, in view of enhancement of Wage Rate under Mahatma Gandhi National Rural Employment Guarantee Scheme by the Government of India:
  - (i) Wage Rate under Mahatma Gandhi National Rural Employment Guarantee Scheme for the unskilled manual workers in Tamil Nadu is enhanced from Rs.132/- to Rs.148/- per day per person.
  - (ii) In order to achieve the minimum wage of Rs.148/- per day per person under Mahatma Gandhi National Rural Employment Guarantee Scheme the Rural Schedule of Rates is revised as follows:
