ORDER:

The Commissioner of Rural Development and Panchayat Raj, in the letter read above, has stated that in G.O. (3D) No.25, Environment and Forest (FR.6) Department, dated 20.03.2012 the Government have issued orders to raise 4000 Ha of Karuvel Plantation in the foreshore of Panchayat and Panchayat Union Tanks through the Forest department and have ordered that the labour component to the tune of about Rs.8.00 crores should be met from the Mahatma Gandhi National Rural Employment Guarantee Scheme funds. The Principal Chief Conservator of Forests has requested for release of funds from the Rural Development Department for implementing the scheme. The Principal Chief Conservator of Forests has also indicated that Karuvel Plantation includes various activities like raising of a nursery, preparation of site, pitting, planting etc. and has informed that the present Rural Schedule of Rates does not cover these items, which are essential for implementation of the scheme through Mahatma Gandhi National Rural Employment Guarantee Scheme. The list of items which are not covered under the Rural Schedule of Rates was also communicated by the Principal Chief Conservator of Forests.

2. The Commissioner of Rural Development and Panchayat Raj has stated that in order to arrive at the rates for the activities listed out by the Principal Chief Conservator of Forests, a detailed time and motion study has been conducted. Based on the Time and Motion Studies conducted in four districts of Tirunelveli, Salem,

Pudukottai and Ramanathapuram the item wise rates to be included in the Rural Schedule of Rates for raising nurseries are detailed below:

All the above activities will be applicable not only for raising nurseries of Karuvel plantation but also for all types of plants.

3. The Commissioner of Rural Development and Panchayat Raj has therefore requested the Government to approve the Rural Schedule of Rates for the various activities involved in the raising of nurseries as mentioned in para 2 above.

4. The Government, after careful examination of the proposal of the Commissioner of Rural Development and Panchayat Raj, have decided to accept it and

approve the Rural Schedule of Rates for the various activities involved in the raising of nurseries in Karuvel plantation and also for all types of plants under Mahatma Gandhi National Rural Employment Guarantee Scheme as mentioned at para 2 above.


