The following Notification will be published in the Tamil Nadu Government Gazette: -

NOTIFICATION

In exercise of the powers conferred by the provisio to Article 309 of the Constitution of India, the Governor of Tamil Nadu hereby makes the following amendments to the Tamil Nadu Government Servants' Conduct Rules, 1973.

2. The amendments hereby made shall come into force on the Twenty First January - 2008.

AMENDMENTS

In the said Rules, in the rule 3, in sub-rule(1),-

- (1) for the expresssion "Rs.1000/-(Rupees one thousand only)", the expression "Rs.5,000/- (Rupees five thousand only)" shall be substituted; and
- (2) for the first and second provisos, the following proviso shall be substituted, namely:-

"Provided that the Government Servant may accept any gift of value exceeding Rs.5000/ - from a personal friend or close relation, on special occasssions such as weddings, anniverseries, funerals and religious functions, when the making or receiving of such gifts is in confirmity with the prevailing religious or social customs and shall make a report to the Government within one month of the acceptance of the gift"
