The following notification will be published in the Tamil Nadu Government Gazette.

NOTIFICATION

In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution of India, the Governor of Tamil Nadu hereby makes the following amendment to the Special Rules for the Tamil Nadu Panchayat Development Service (Section 39 in Volume II of the Tamil Nadu Services manual, 1969)

2. The amendment hereby made shall be deemed to have come into force on the 21st November 1990.

AMENDMENT

In the said Special Rules, in rule-3, in the Table, for the proviso to item (a) in column (3) against the entry "Divisional Development Officer" in column (1) and the entry "(c) by Direct Recruitment", in column (2), the following proviso shall be substituted, namely: -

"Provided that in respect of candidates belonging to Scheduled Castes, Schedules Tribes, Most Backward Classes, Denotified Communities and Backward Classes, the minimum and maximum age limit shall be twenty one years and thirty five years respectively."
