**ORDER**

In the G.O. first read above orders were issued that each District is a separate unit upto the category of Block Development Officer and the Collectors are the appointing authorities for the post of Block Development Officer at District Level.

2. The Director of Rural Development, Chennai, in his letter second read above has sent proposal for delegation of powers to the Collectors to issue foreign service terms and conditions for the Block Development Officer, since the appointing powers were vested with the Collectors.

3. The Government have examined the proposal of the Director of Rural Development and consider that the District Collectors may be delegated with the powers to depute the personnel of Panchayat Development Department upto the level of Block Development Officers under their control to foreign bodies coming under the purview of the State Government under foreign service terms.

4. The Government accordingly direct that the District Collectors of the concerned District be delegated with the powers to depute personnel of Panchayat Development Department upto the cadre of Block Development Officer to foreign bodies coming under the purview of the State Government subject to usual terms and conditions specified under FR 110(b) and 114.

5. Necessary amendment to FR 110 (b) will be issued by Personnel Administrative Reforms (FR IV) Department separately.

6. This order issues with the concurrence of Personnel and Administrative Reforms Department vide its U.O.No 34356/FR11/99-1 dated 23.6.99
