ORDER

The Government in the G.O.1st read above have fixed the estimate of vacancies as 187 for the post of Assistant Engineers in the Tamil Nadu Panchayat Development Service of the Rural Development and Panchayat Raj Department for the year 2006-2007 to be filled up by direct recruitment through the Tamil Nadu Public Service Commission. In the Government D.O.letter read above the Tamil Nadu Public Service Commission has been informed of this and the Commission has been requested to recruit suitable candidates for the vacancies approved by the Government. The Director of Rural Development & Panchayat Raj, in his letter read above has stated that in pursuance of the approval of the panel of 35 Assistant Executive Engineers for the year 2006-2007, in G.O.(D) No.750 Rural Development & Panchayat Raj Department, dated 21.12.2006, 35 Assistant Engineers have been promoted as Assistant Executive Engineers vide his proceedings No.46078/2006/EE1 dated 28.12.2006. He has further stated that one Thiru G. Selvakumaran, Assistant Engineer has been included in the panel of Assistant Executive Engineers for the year 2005-2006 as per orders issued in G.O.(4D) No.2, Rural Development and Panchayat Raj Department dated 7.3.2007. He has further reported that 36 posts of Assistant Engineers which fell vacant during the year 2006-2007 were originally filled up by direct recruitment through the Tamil Nadu Public Service Commission. He has therefore requested to approve the additional vacancies of 36 posts of Assistant Engineer, in addition to the 187 posts of Assistant Engineers already approved by the Government for the year 2006-2007.

2. The Government have examined the proposal of the Director of Rural Development & Panchayat Raj. The 36 additional vacancies in the post of Assistant Engineer have arisen because the panel of 35 Assistant Executive Engineers for 2006-2007 got approved and 35 Assistant Engineers got promoted as Assistant Executive Engineers in 2006-2007 itself and on appeal the name of 1 Assistant Engineer was included in the Assistant Executive Engineers panel for the year 2005-2006 and promoted after the 187 Assistant Engineer vacancies for 2006-2007 were intimated to Tamil Nadu Public Service Commission. The Government on the approval of the Staff Committee have decided to revise the estimate of vacancies for the post of Assistant Engineers in Rural Development and Panchayat Raj Department for 2006-2007 from 187 to 223 to be recruited through Tamil Nadu Public Service Commission.

3. Accordingly, the Government fix the estimate of vacancies for the post of Assistant Engineers as 223 (187+36) in the Tamil Nadu Panchayat Development Service of the RD & PR Department for the year 2006-2007 to be filled up by direct recruitment through the Tamil Nadu Public Service Commission.
