ORDER:

In the Government Order first read above, orders had been issued for release of Rs.183981.36/- lakhs as State Finance Commission Grants to Rural Local Bodies i.e. Village Panchayats, Panchayat Unions and District Panchayats on monthly basis from April 2010 to January 2011 including Infrastructure Gap filling Fund based on the allocation made in the Budget Estimate 2010-11. In the Government Order second read above, orders had been issued for the release of Rs.49440.04/- lakhs as balance of State Finance Commission population based grant for the months of February 2011 and March 2011.

2. The Commissioner of Rural Development and Panchayat Raj in his letter third read above has stated that the Government have allocated additional funds towards State Finance Commission (SFC) Grant for the year 2010-11 as detailed below:
