Tamil Nadu Panchayats (Devolution and Delegation of the functions of Chairman of Panchayat Union Council or District Panchayat) Rules, 1999

(G.O.Ms.No.140, Rural Development (C4), dated 21st July, 1999)

Under sub-section (5) of Section 54 of the Tamil Nadu Panchayats Act, 1994 (Tamil Nadu Act 21 of 1994) and in supersession of the Rules relating to Devolution of Chairman's functions, the Governor of Tamil Nadu hereby makes the following Rules :-

RULES

1. Short title.- These Rules may be called the Tamil Nadu Panchayats (devolution and delegation of the functions of Chairman of Panchayat Union Council or District Panchayat) Rules, 1999.

2. Restriction.- Where the absence from jurisdiction of the Chairman of Panchayat Union Council or District Panchayat is within the State of Tamil Nadu and is on business connected with the functions of the Panchayat Union Council or District Panchayat as the case may be, his functions except to the extent, if any, to which they have been delegated to the Vice-Chairman of the Panchayat Union Council or District Panchayat, as the case may be, shall not devolve on the said Vice-Chairman.
