## Tamil Nadu Panchayats (Limitation of time for Appeals) Rules, 1999

## (G.O.Ms.No.141, Rural Development (C4), dated 21<sup>st</sup> July 1999)

In exercise of the powers conferred by clause (*xii*) of sub-section (2) Section 242 of the Tamil Nadu Panchayats Act, 1994 (Tamil Nadu Act 21 of 1994) and in supersession of the Rules relating of Limitation of Time for Appeals, the Governor of Tamil Nadu hereby makes the following Rules.-

## **RULES**

- **1. Short title.-** These Rules may be called the Tamil Nadu Panchayats (Limitation of time for Appeals) Rules 1999.
- 2. Appellate Authority and time limit for appeal. Save as otherwise provided in the Tamil Nadu Panchayats Act, 1994 (Tamil Nadu Act 21 of 1994) or in the Rules may thereunder, every appeal under that Act, or any such Rule shall, subject to the provisions of Section 5 of the Indian Limitation Act, 1908 (Central Act IX of 1908), be presented to the Inspector:-
- (a) where the appeal is against an order granting a licence or permission, within thirty days from the date of publication of the order on the notice board of the Panchayat; and
- (b) in other cases, within thirty days from the date of receipt of the order or proceedings against which the appeal is made.
