# 28.40 High Level Committee recommendations on Non Conventional Energy Sources - Decision of the Government

#### **ORDER**

Under the revised Rule 73 of Indian Constitution 1994, the Tamil Nadu Panchayats Act was enacted. According to the Act three tier Panchayats set up was formed for which elections conducted and elected members assumed charge in the Panchayats, Panchayat Union and District Councils. As per Rule 243G of 1994 of Tamil Nadu Panchayat Act and Rules 257 of the Said Act, the economic and social welfare Programmes implemented by the three tier Panchayats set up for which a High level committee was constituted with selected Legislators as Members and the Minister for Rural Development and Local Administration as Convenor has examined the Devolution of powers to the three tier panchayats setup under the subject viz., "Non Conventional Energy Sources".

- 2. The Government have examined the recommendations of the High Level Committee made under the Subject 15 "**Non Conventional Energy Sources**". In supersession of the orders issued in the G.O. read above, the Government have decided to accept those recommendations as mentioned in the Annexure to this order.
- 3. The Chairman and Managing Director., Tamil Nadu Energy Development Agency is requested to take necessary action with reference to the above orders of the Government. The Chairman and Managing Director, Tamil Nadu Energy Development Agency is also requested to acknowledge the receipt of this order.
