### 30.7 Absorption of Doctors and Other Staff Working in Panchayat Union Dispensaries into Department of Indian Medicine and Homoeopathy

#### ORDER

In the Government Order first read above orders have been issued transferring 64 Rural Dispensaries with the following 81 number of Staff to the control of Indian Medicine and Homoeopathy Department from Panchayat Union dispensaries.

The Special Commissioner of Indian Medicine and Homoeopathy, Chennai in the letter third read above has proposed to absorb most of the Panchayat Union Dispensaries to the District Headquarters Hospital and the rest of the Panchayat Union Dispensaries are to be retained in original places. He has suggested the following for the absorption of doctors and other staff working in Panchayat Union Dispensaries into Department of Indian Medicine and Homoeopathy:

- (i) The Panchayat Union Dispensaries that are located in the areas where ISM wing is available within a radius of 8 Kms can be shifted to a Primary Health Centre beyond 8 Kms, or at the District Headquarters Hospital. A new ISM wing can be opened, and the posts existing in the Panchayat Union Dispensary can be created the Primary Health Centre or the District Headquarters Hospital and the incumbents of these Panchayat Union Dispensaries can be absorbed in these newly created wings.
- (ii) The Dispensaries should be handed over with all furniture, equipments, and medicines available.
- (iii) The building from where the dispensaries have been shifted could be handed over to Village Health Nurses to enable them to carry out their RCH Work provided equivalent space as constructed area is provided in an alternative Primary Health Centre or Hospital for ISM.
- (iv) Concurrence of the Tamil Nadu Public Service Commission should be obtained for the posts of Assistant Medical Officers being absorbed into the Department.

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- (v) Budget provision may be made under relevant head of accounts for the expenditure viz. establishment, medicine, linen, equipment etc. of the dispensaries.
- (vi) The two posts of Assistant Medical Officers (existing one + addition of one post by way of shifting) in the District Headquarters Hospitals shall be filled up through counseling or through other means in such a way that the team of two Assistant Medical Officers shall comprise one male and one female Assistant Medical Officer. Due to unavoidable circumstances, if the team of two Assistant Medical Officers cannot be filled up in the sex ratio of 1:1 at a particular point of time, the same ratio shall be adhered to while considering transfer in the next earliest opportunity.
- (vii) The shifting of these dispensaries to the District Head Quarters Hospitals, will be purely on trial basis for the period of two years. If no substantial improvement of OP census is observed even after the trial period, the said wing may be transferred to the Primary Health Centres in suitable place where there is no ISM wing. He has further requested that powers may be vested with him to change the above dispensaries at his own discretion.

3. The Government have examined the proposal of the Special Commissioner of Indian Medicine and Homoeopathy, Chennai and have decided to accept the proposal, subject to the following conditions:-

a) the 81 number of staff of the 64 Panchayat Union dispensaries should be transferred to the Department of Indian Medicine and Homoeopathy along with the posts.

b) The concurrence of the Tamil Nadu Public Service Commission may be obtained after the staff transferred from the Panchayat Union dispensaries are temporarily appointed in the Department of Indian Medicine and Homoeopathy so as to avoid undue hardships to the patients.

4. Accordingly the Government issue the following orders:-

- a) The Government direct that the following posts shall be transferred to Indian Medicine and Homoeopathy Department from Rural Development and Panchayat Raj Department with immediate effect.

- b) The Rural Development Department shall transfer the dispensaries to Indian Medicine and Homoeopathy Department along with furniture and equipments.
- c) Sanction is accorded for a sum of Rs. 5000/- (Rupees five thousand only) per dispensary per month for 64 dispensaries at a total cost of Rs. 3.20 lakhs (Rupees three lakhs and twenty thousand only) per month to make provisions for medicines.
- d) Sanction is also accorded for a sum of Rs. 32,000/- per annum (Rupees Thirty two thousand only) for linen.
- e) The list of 27 dispensaries retained in its original places is indicated in Annexure-I.

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- f) The list of 37 dispensaries to be transferred to other places is indicated in Annexure-II.
- g) The Special Commissioner of Indian Medicine and Homoeopathy, Chennai is requested to send necessary proposal to the Government for obtaining the concurrence of Tamil Nadu Public Service Commission after completion of the transfer of post to Indian Medicine and Homoeopathy Department.
- h) The staff mentioned in para 4 (a) shall be eligible for pay and other allowances as per the orders in force.

5. The expenditure sanctioned in para 4 above shall be debited under the following head of account:-

The Special Commissioner of Indian Medicine and Homoeopathy is directed to send necessary draft explanatory note for inclusion of the expenditure in the Supplementary Estimates 2007-08 to obtain the approval of the Legislature at the appropriate stage.
