13. ASSIGNED REVENUES

NOTIFICATIONS

NOTIFICATION – I

Under sub-section (4) of section 21 of the Mines and Minerals (Regulation and Development) Act 1957 (Central Act 67 of 1957), read with the Government of India, Ministry of Steel and Mines, Department of Mines. Notification dated the 6th February 1979, the Governor of Tamil Nadu hereby specially empowers also the Joint Directors in the Department of Geology and Mining, if any, in the districts, the Presidents of Village Panchayatys, the Executive Officers of Town Panchayatys, Town ships and the Commissioners of Municipality and Corporations to exercise the powers under the said sub-section with their respective jurisdiction. Provided that the above powers shall be exercisable by the above authorities only in respect of minor minerals namely building and road construction stones including gravel, ordinary sand, earth and turf and ordinary clay including silt, brick and tile clay.

NOTIFICATION – II

In exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (2) of section 26 of the Mines and Minerals (Regulation and Development) Act 1957 (Central Act 67 of 1957), the Government of Tamil Nadu hereby directs that the powers exercisable by the State Government under sub-section (5) of section 21 of the said Act shall be exercisable also by the Revenue Divisional Officers concerned in respect of cases falling within their jurisdiction, provided that the above power shall be exercisable by the Revenue Divisional Officers only by respect of minor minerals namely building and road construction stones including gravel, ordinary sand, earth and turf and ordinary clay including silt, brick and tile clay.

NOTIFICATION – III

Under section 22 of the Mines and Minerals (Regulation and Development) Act 1957 (Central Act 67 of 1957) the Governor of Tamil Nadu hereby authorizes also the Revenue Divisional Officers concerned to make complaint under the said section in respect of cases falling within their jurisdiction relating to minor minerals namely, building and road construction stones including gravel, ordinary sand, earth and turf and ordinary clay including silt, brick and tile clay.
