ORDER:

In the Government Order first read above, Government had issued orders for the release of `.183981.36 lakhs being the devolution grant to the Rural Local Bodies i.e. Village Panchayats, Panchayat Unions and District Panchayats and authorized the Commissioner of Rural Development and Panchayat Raj to draw and disburse the amount sanctioned on monthly basis i.e. from April 2010 to January 2011 to the Rural Local Bodies as indicated therein. Accordingly, the Commissioner of Rural Development and Panchayat Raj has released the funds.

2. The Commissioner of Rural Development and Panchayat Raj in the letter second read above has stated that the Government have allocated a sum of `.233421.40 lakhs as State Finance Commission (SFC) grant in the Budget Estimate for 2010-2011 as detailed below:
