ORDER

1. The Second State Finance Commission in Para No. 13.2.4 of Chapter IV has recommended that adjustment of Local Cess Surcharge and Local cess needs to be monitored both at District Level and State Level. At the district level, Collector shall review this along with the Personal Assistant (General) or the Additional Personal Assistant Concerned on the revenue side and Assistant Director (panchayats) on the Development side. At the State level, the Principal Commissioner and Commissioner of Revenue Administration, Director of Rural Development and a Collector may meet once in a year and monitor the process for the state as a whole. This recommendation was accepted by High Level Committee.

2. Based on the recommendation of the Second State Finance Commission the Director of Rural Development has sent the proposal for constitution of District and state level committee. The Government have examined the proposal of the Director of Rural Development carefully and decided to accept the proposal of the Director of Rural Development and direct that the District and State level Committee shall be constituted as follows;

TERM OF REFERENCE

At District Level the Collectors shall review bi-monthly the collection of Land Revenue and adjustment of Local cess, Local Cess Surcharge to panchayats and panchayts Unions and ensure prompt adjustment of dues. At Stat Level the above Committee will meet once in a year and monitor the process for the State as a whole.
