

20.6 Monetary limit for write off in the cases of lost property

ORDER

In the G.O first read above, instructions were issued prescribing monetary limit and delegation of powers to write off in the case of loss of property belonging to a Panchayat due to theft, fire or other accidents. In the G.O 2nd read above, revised orders were issued delegating power to officers to write off losses due to theft, fire or other accident.

2. In his letter 3rd read above the Director of Rural Development has proposed that a ceiling as detailed below may be fixed requiring the sanction of authorities viz, Assistant Director of Rural Development (Panchayats) and Collector.

3.The Government have carefully examined the proposal of the Director of Rural Development and sanction the following delegation of powers to the officers noted against each in regard to writing off losses due to theft, fire, or other accidents in the Panchayats.

| Assistant Director (Panchayats) | Up to Rs 1,000 |
| Collector | From Rs.1,001/- to Rs. 5,000 |
| Director of Rural Development | From Rs.5,001/- to Rs. 10,000 |
| Government | Above Rs. 10,000/- |

Sanction of Government should be obtained in all cases exceeding Rs.10,000/-
