## **ORDER**

Their appointment was continued from time to time and lastly continued upto 14.09.2001 in the Government Order fifth read above.

- 2. Now the Government have analysed the work of the Makkal Nala paniyalargal and considers that there are enough staff in Panchayat Union and Village Panchayat level to look after the works presently being looked after by Makkal Nala Paniyalargal.
- 3. The Government after careful examination direct that the posts of Makkal Nala Paniyalargal created in the Government Order first read above and last continued in the Government Order fifth read above be disbanded with immediate effect.
