In exercise of the powers conferred by clause (iv) of sub-section (2) of by 242 of the Tamil Nadu Panchayats Act, 1994 (Tamil Nadu Act 21 of 1994), the Governor of Tamil Nadu hereby makes the following amendment to the Tamil Nadu Panchayats (Resignation of Chairman, Vice-Chairman and Members of District Panchayat, Chairman, Vice-Chairman and Members of Panchayat Union Council and of the President, Vice-President and Members of Village Panchayat) Rules, 1999.

AMENDMENT

In the said Rules

To Rule 3, the following proviso shall be added, namely -

“Provided that whenever only the President of a Village Panchayat is elected and the Village Panchayat could not be constituted, the resignation of such Presidents shall be accepted by the Inspector”.
