

13.2 Waiver of Land Revenue for the lands affected by floods in the year 1997

ORDER

Honorable Chief Minister has announced on the floor of the Legislative Assembly on 6.4.98 to the effect that the agriculturists were very much affected by the heavy rain during the last year monsoon. As a measure of relief, the land revenue for the current year (Fasli 1407) amounting to Rs.43,33,00,000/- (Rupees forty three crores and thirty three lakhs only) would be waived and that the amount if any already paid by the ryots would be adjusted against the land revenue due from them in the next year.

2) The Principal Commissioner and Commissioner of Revenue Administration in his letter third read above has stated that the average rainfall in this state during the last North East Monsoon is 782.45mm. This is more than the normal rainfall in this state by 321.68mm. Hence there is excess rainfall of 69.81% He has requested to issue orders.

3) In pursuance of the announcement made by the Honorable Chief Minister on the floor of the Legislative Assembly, the Government direct to waive the land revenues including local cess and Locall cess surcharge to the tune of Rs.43,33,00.000/- (Rupees forty three crores and thirty three lakhs only) in the entire state of Tamil Nadu in respect of the current year (Fasli 1407). The amount if any already paid by the ryots shall be adjusted against the land revenue due from them in the next year.

4) This order issues with the concurrence of the Finance Department vide its U.O.No.2398/FS/P/98, dated 3.6.1998.
