ORDER:

Member of Legislative Assembly Constituency Development Scheme was introduced during 1997-98 and a sum of Rs.25 lakhs was allotted to each Assembly Constituency under this scheme. Since then, this amount has been enhanced step by step and Rs.1 crore and 50 lakhs has been allotted to each Assembly Constituency for 2008-09 under this scheme. In the Government Order read above, guidelines for implementation of the Member of Legislative Assembly Constituency Development Scheme for the year 2009-2010 were issued.

2. The Hon'ble Minister for Finance has announced on the floor of Assembly on 21.7.2009 that the Member of Legislative Assembly Constituency Development fund for each Constituency is enhanced from Rs.1 crore 50 lakhs to Rs.1 crore 70 lakhs from the year 2009-2010.

3. Accordingly, the Government issue the following orders: -

(i) Member of Legislative Assembly Constituency Development Fund for each Assembly Constituency is increased from Rs.1,50,00,000/- (Rupees one crore and fifty lakhs) to Rs.1,70,00,000/- (Rupees one crore and seventy lakhs) from the year 2009-2010

(ii) Out of the present allocation of Rs.1,70,00,000/- (Rupees one crore and seventy lakhs) per Assembly Constituency, 50% of the amount (i.e) Rs.85,00,000/- (Rupees eighty five lakhs only) shall be earmarked for 'tied component' and the remaining 50% (i.e) Rs.85,00,000/- (Rupees eighty five lakhs only) shall be earmarked for 'untied component'.

(iii) Except the change indicated in para 3 (ii) above, there is no other change in the Guidelines issued in the G.O.(MS) No.61, Rural Development and Panchayat Raj Department, dated 16.7.2009, for the implementation of Member of Legislative Assembly Constituency Development Scheme for the year 2009-2010 and these guidelines have to be followed for the year 2009-2010.

4. The expenditure as sanctioned at para 3(i) above shall be debitable under the following heads of account:

(80% of the Expenditure)

 (i) 4515-00-Capital Outlay on other Rural Development Programmes -800 - other Expenditure – Schemes in the Eleventh Five year Plan - II State Plan – JF – Execution of other schemes under Member of Legislative Assembly Constituency Development Scheme – 16 Major Works. (DPC 4515 00 800 JF 1602)

(20% of the Expenditure)

 (ii) 4515-00-Capital Outlay on other Rural Development Programmes – 789 Special Component Plan for scheduled castes – Schemes in the Eleventh Five year Plan. II – State Plan – JB – Execution of other schemes under Member of Legislative Assembly Constituency Development Scheme under Special Component Plan – 16 Major Works. (DPC 4515 00 789 JB 1606)

5. Consequent on the enhancement of allocation for each Assembly Constituency from Rs.1.50 crores to Rs.1.70 crores, an additional amount of Rs.47,00,00,000/- (Rupees forty seven crores) is required during 2009-2010. This additional expenditure will be brought to the Notice of the Legislature by inclusion in the First Supplementary Estimates 2009-2010. Necessary funds will be provided in RE/FMA 2009-2010. Pending provision of such funds in RE/FMA 2009-2010, the Commissioner of Rural Development and Panchayat Raj is authorized to incur this expenditure and to include this expenditure while sending necessary proposals for RE/FMA 2009-2010 to the Government in Finance Department and in the Supplementary Estimates 2009-2010.
