### 1.54 2007-08 - Provision of vehicles for V.V.I.P. visits for Directorate of Rural Development at a cost of Rs.18 Lakhs

#### ORDER

The Directorate of Rural Development and Panchayat Raj is implementing various centrally sponsored schemes and State Government Schemes. The VVIPs and high level monitoring Officers frequently visit the State to inspect development works and also to attend various review meetings and submit evaluation reports. It is therefore necessary to provide two Vehicles for the VVIPs and VIPs visiting the State. It is therefore proposed to provide two Vehicles at the disposal of the Directorate of Rural Development and Panchayat Raj for providing transport facilities to VVIPs and VIPs visiting the state and also for the Officers of Directorate of Rural Development and Panchayat Raj.

2. The Standing Finance Committee has approved the proposal for provision of two Vehicles for Directorate of Rural Development and Panchayat Raj for VVIPs visiting the State and other use at the cost of Rs.18.00 lakhs under part II Schemes for the year 2007-08.

3. Sanction is therefore accorded for non-recurring expenditure of Rs.18.00 lakhs (Rupees eighteen lakhs only) for provision of two Mahindra Scorpio or equivalent Vehicles for VVIPs visits and use by Officers of the Directorate of Rural Development and Panchayat Raj, Chennai-15.

4. The expenditure sanctioned in para 3 above shall be debited to the following head of account:

"2515-00-other Rural Development Programme-001-Direction and Administration-1Non Plan-AA. Directorate of Rural Development-21-Motor Vehicle 01. Purchase (DPC2515-00-001-2018)"

5. The Director of Rural Development and Panchayat Raj, Chennai-15, is authorised to draw and incur the amount sanctioned in para 3 above. He is requested to send the Utilisation Certificate to Government within the prescribed time.

6. The Director of Rural Development and Panchayat Raj is directed that the vehicles shall be purchased duly following the existing tender and codal procedures.
