

1.55 2007-08 - Provision of 16 five door hard top Vehicles to District Level Officers at a cost of Rs. 72.00 lakhs

ORDER

The District Level Officers of Rural Development and Panchayat Raj Department closely monitor the proper implementation of various schemes. The visits by the various District Level officers and inspection at the Block level should be done effectively to ensure quality in the execution of work and proper utilization of funds. Since vehicles have not been provided to the District Level Officers, they find it very difficult to inspect and monitor the execution of the schemes. It is therefore proposed provide Vehicles to District Level Officers on the basis of requirements.

2. The State Planning Commission has cleared the proposal under part II Schemes for the year 2007-08 of Rural Development and Panchayat Raj Department on 12.1.07 and the Standing Finance Committee has approved the proposal for provision of 16 Vehicles to District Level Officers at the cost of Rs.72.00 lakhs Under Part II Scheme for the year 2007-08.

3. Sanction is therefore accorded for non recurring expenditure of Rs.72.00 lakhs (Rupees Seventy two lakhs only) for provision of 16 Vehicles to District Level Officers, of the Rural Development and Panchayat Raj Department.

4. The Government also direct that Director of Rural Development and Panchayat Raj shall purchase 16 Nos of 5 door hard top vehicles from among vehicles listed in Government Order No.1229 Home (Tr-IV) Department Dated 21.12.2006 on Director General of Supplies and Disposal rates

5. The expenditure sanctioned in para 3 above shall be debited to the following head account:

6. The Director of Rural Development and Panchayat Raj, Chennai is authorised to draw and disburse the amount sanctioned in para 3 above and also requested to send the utilisation certificate to Government within the prescribed time. The Director of Rural Development and Panchayat Raj is also authorized to make need based internal allocation and reallocation of Vehicles

7. The Director of Rural Development and Panchayat Raj is directed to ensure that the Vehicles shall be purchased duly following the existing Tender and Codal procedures.
