7.14 2005 – 06 Release of balance amount under Comprehensive Road Infrastructure Development Programme

ORDER

In the G.O. first read above, administrative sanction was accorded for a sum of Rs.100 Crores (Rupees One Hundred crores only) for strengthening of Bus Plying / non Bus Plying Panchayat and Panchayat Union roads to facilitate smooth transportation in rural areas under the Comprehensive road infrastructure Development Programme for the year 2005-2006.

2. Out of the sanctioned amount Rs.100 crores, a sum of Rs.75 crores was sanctioned for the year 2005-2006 under Demand No.40 and the same has been drawn and disbursed to all Districts during 2005-06.

3. In the G.O. third read above, a sum of Rs.12.50 crores was released form out of the amount of Rs.25.00 crores provided for this purpose in IBE 2006-07.

4. In the reference fourth read above, the Director of Rural Development & Panchayat Raj has sent a proposal and requested the Government to release the balance amount of Rs.12.50 crores, under CRIDP to carry out works which are under progress, so that the funds could be utilised fully within this Financial Year.

5. The Government after detailed examination decided to accept the proposal of the Director of Rural Development & Panchayat Raj and accordingly release a sum of Rs.12.50 crores (Rupees twelve crores and fifty lakhs only) being the balance amount available under CRIDP 2005-2006. The Director of Rural Development & Panchayat Raj is authorised to draw the amount sanctioned above and disburse it to the District Collectors for implementation of the CRIDP.

6. The expenditure sanctioned in para 5 above shall be debited to the following sub-head of account.

"4515-Capital Outlay on other Rural Development Programmes – 800 other Expenditure – Scheme in the Tenth Five Year Plan – II – State Plan JK Comprehensive Road Infrastructure Development Programme – Rural Panchayat and Panchayat Union Roads – 16 Major works"

(DPC – 4515 – 00 – 800 – JK – 1602)

7. The Director of Rural Development and Panchayat Raj should ensure the quality of work as per the stipulated standards by issuing detailed instructions to the concerned authorities. He is further instructed to closely monitored the progress and ensure that the quality parameters are strictly adhered to in the executions of the works. He is also directed to satisfy himself that the above work, have not been included/undertaken in other schemes before calling for tender.
