Construction of SHG Complex near Valluvarkottam, Chennai at a cost of Rs.10.72 crores – Administrative sanction Accorded.

ORDER

In the Government Order 1st read above a sum of Rs.190.095 crores was allocated for the restoration of Livelihood in the Tsunami affected rural areas of the 12 coastal districts of Tamil Nadu under the Tsunami Emergency Assistance Project funded by the Asian Development Bank. Out of this total allocation, Rs.38 crores has been earmarked for Community Infrastructure development as a grant, which would support the Economic Activities of the Self Help Groups, among others.

- 2. In the Government Order 2nd read above, Government have accorded inprinciple approval to construct a State Level Exhibition cum Marketing Complex for SHGs at a cost of Rs.5.00 crores on the land allotted to Rural Development and Panchayat Raj Department, near Valluvarkottam, Chennai from out of the funds earmarked for community infrastructure development under livelihood assistance provided by the Asian Development Bank and requested the Project Implementation Officer, Tsunami Project Implementation Unit to submit a detailed plan and estimates expeditiously for according administrative sanction.
- 3. The Project Director, Tsunami Project Implementation Unit in the letter 3rd read above has sent a Detailed Project Report along with Plans and Estimates at a cost of Rs.10.72 crores, seeking administrative sanction for the construction of the SHG complex near Valluvarkottam in Chennai for the benefit of the Self Help Groups in Tamil Nadu. He has further stated that sufficient funds are available to meet the cost of the project under the Livelihood grant component of Tsunami Emergency Assistance Project.
- 4. The Government after detailed examination of the proposal accord Administrative Sanction to construct the SHG Complex at a cost of Rs10.72 crores for the benefit of the Self Help Groups and its members for promoting economic activities on the land allotted to Rural Development and Panchayat Raj Department near Valluvarkottam in Chennai.
