ORDER :

The Government have sanctioned Engineering Staff to the twelve Tsunami affected coastal districts for the implementation of externally aided project of Tsunami Emergency Assistance Project (TEAP) of Asian Development Bank and Emergency Tsunami Reconstruction Project (ETRP) of World Bank.

2. The Project Implementation Officer has reported that the Director of Rural Development and Panchayat Raj has expressed his inability in deputing Executive Engineers, Senior Draughting Officers and Technical Assistants. The Managing Director, Tamil Nadu Housing Board, who was requested to send a list of technical personnel, has furnished a list of 26 persons in the Cadre of Assistant Executive Engineer, Assistant engineer Junior Draughting Officer and Technical Assistants. Since the implementation phase of this project is already delayed, the additional process of getting Government orders for posting the Engineers will adversely affect the field activities. The Project Implementation Officer has therefore, requested the Government to issue necessary orders for delegating the powers to the Project Implementation Officer for posting of Engineering staff upto the level of Assistant Executive Engineer. He has also recommended that the post of Technical Assistant with the consolidated pay of Rs.4,000/- per month may be filled up by the District Collectors by getting the list from the Employment Exchange and necessary powers to this effect can be given to the District Collectors.

3. After careful examination, the Government hereby accept the proposal of the Project Implementation Officer and delegates the powers to the Project Implementation Officer to issue orders for transfer and posting upto the level of Assistant Executive Engineer on deputation subject to the condition that such powers shall be exercised by him in accordance with the guidelines / instructions/ orders of the Minister/ Secretary to Government concerned.

4. Regarding recruitment of Technical Assistants through Employment Exchange, orders will be issued separately.
