



ABSTRACT

Grants – State Finance Commission Grants for the year 2017-18 – Release of Rs.2874,17,92,142/- to Village Panchayats, Panchayat Unions and District Panchayats from April 2017 to January 2018 – Orders – Issued.

ORDER:

In the Government order first read above, as per the recommendations of Fifth State Finance Commission, the Government have ordered that the vertical sharing ratio for devolution of State Finance Commission Grant to rural and urban local bodies shall be in the ratio of 56:44. The Government have also ordered to apportion the devolution grant of the rural local bodies among the Village Panchayats, Panchayat Unions and District Panchayats in the ratio of 55:37:8.

- 2. The Director of Rural Development and Panchayat Raj in his letter second read above has sent necessary proposals for the release of State Finance Commission Grant to rural local bodies for the year 2017-18 as stated below:-
 - (i) The State Government have made a provision in the Budget Estimate for Rs.5159,39,85,000 for the year 2017-18 as detailed below:-

(ii) Village Panchayat - Minimum Grant & Population Grant: As per the Fifth State Finance Commission recommendations, the Government have ordered increasing the Minimum lumpsum Grant to Village Panchayats from Rs.5 lakh to Rs.7 lakh per Village Panchayat per year. This amount will be deducted from the balance share of State Finance Commission devolution intended for Village Panchayats as the first charge and distributed to all Village Panchayats on monthly basis. The balance amount from out of the share of Village Panchayats in the State Finance Commission devolution will be distributed on the horizontal sharing ratio as mentioned below:-

Panchayat Union - Minimum Grant & Population Grant: As per the Fifth (iii) State Finance Commission recommendations, the Government have issued orders increasing the minimum lumpsum grant from Rs.30 lakh to Rs.40 Lakh per Panchayat Union per year. This amount will be deducted from the balance share of State Finance devolution intended for Panchayat Unions as the first charge and distributed to all Panchayat Unions on monthly basis as per the formula.

(iv) District Panchayat - Population Grant: As per the Fifth State Finance Commission recommendations, the amount entitled for District Panchayat will

be distributed on the basis of above formula.

(v) Capital Grant Fund and Pooled Fund Deficit: In respect of Capital Grant Fund and Pooled Fund Deficit detailed proposals will be sent to Government separately by the DRD&PR.

3. The Director of Rural Development and Panchayat Raj has requested the Government to issue orders for release of the share of devolution grant to Village Panchayats, Panchayat Unions and District Panchayats in monthly instalments as detailed below:-

The Director of Rural Development and Panchayat Raj has also requested the Government to issue orders sanctioning the minimum grant of Rs.7 lakh per year at the rate of Rs.60,000/- per month from April 2017 to January 2018 (10 months) and Rs.50,000/- per month for February and March 2018 (2 months) to each Village Panchayat and similarly, Rs.40 lakh per year at the rate of Rs.3,00,000/- per month from April 2017 to January 2018 (10 months) and Rs.5,00,000/- per month for February and March 2018 (2 months) to each Block Panchayats on monthly basis as per the recommendations of 5th State Finance Commission towards the Minimum Grant for the financial year (April 2017-Mar 2018) and Population Grant for Village Panchayats, Panchayat Unions and District Panchayats from April 2017 to January 2018 are as below:-

- 5. The Director of Rural Development and Panchayat Raj has also requested the Government to issue orders authorizing him to draw and disburse the amount to the three tiers of Panchayat Raj Institutions and also to make necessary adjustments/deductions for committed expenditure such as pension commitment.
- 6. The Government have carefully examined the proposal of the Director of Rural Development and Panchayat Raj in the light of the orders issued in the Government order first read above and decided to release a sum of Rs. 2874,17,92,142/- (Rupees Two Thousand Eight hundred and Seventy Four crores Seventeen lakhs Ninety two thousand and One Hundred Forty Two only) as State Finance Commission Grant to Village Panchayats, Panchayat Unions and District Panchayats for the month of April 2017 to January 2018 out of total allocation of State Finance Commission Grant of Rs.5159,39,85,000/- for the year 2017-18 as follows:-

The Director of Rural Development and Panchayat Raj is authorised to disburse the minimum grant of Rs.7.00 lakh per year at the rate of Rs.60,000/- per month from April 2017 to January 2018 (10 months) and Rs.50,000/- per month for February and March 2018 (2 months) to each village panchayat and Rs.40 lakh per year at the rate of Rs.3.00 lakh per month from April

2017 to January 2018 (10 months) and Rs.5.00 lakh per month for February and March 2018 (2 months) per month to each Block Panchayats on monthly basis as per the recommendations of Fifth State Finance Commission.

- 9. The Pay and Accounts Officer / Treasury Officers concerned are requested to admit and honour the bills as and when presented by the Director of Rural Development and Panchayat Raj, if they are found otherwise in order.
