### ORDER:

The Government have also ordered to apportion the Devolution Grant of Rural Local Bodies among the Village Panchayats, Panchayat Unions and District Panchayats in the ratio of 55:378 and stand that the funds of Rural Local Bodies under Fifth State Finance Commission will be distributed as follows:

(i)	Capital Grant Fund	20%
ii)	Pooled Fund for Deficit Rural Local Bodies	10%
IID	Devolution Grant	70%

 As per the Fifth State Finance Commission recommendations, the horizontal distribution of State Finance Commission devolution to Rural Local Bodies should be done on the basis of following formula:

(a)	Total population (2011 Census)	60%
b)	SC/ST population	15%
c)	Area	15%
d)	Per capita consumption expenditure distance	10%

4. In the letter 5<sup>th</sup> read above, the Commissioner of Rural Development and Panchayat Raj has stated that in Budget Estimate 2022-23, the following provisions have made under the head of accounts pertaining to SFC Devolution Grant for Rural Local Bodies for the year 2022-23 vide Budget Estimate for the year 2022-23, Demand No.42 of Rural Devolument and Panchayat Raj Department:
