ORDER:

In the Government order first read above, the Government issued orders for pooling of the Assigned Revenue due to Rural Local Bodies from the proceeds of Local Cess, Local Cess Surcharge, Surcharge on Stamp Duty and Entertainment Tax (except Social Forestry receipts and income from Mines and Minerals) at the State Level and apportioning the same to the Rural Local Bodies. The levy of Local Cess and Local Cess Surcharge had been dispensed with by Government since 2009-10. In the Government order second read above, a fund known as "Fund for Priority Schemes in Rural Areas" was constituted and orders for its utilization of the said fund were also issued.

2. In the Government Order 2nd read above, the Government have accorded to sanction a sum of Rs.1003,00,46,610/- towards Pooling of Assigned Revenue for the year 2022-23 and release the first instalment of Rs.501,50,23,305/- as being the 50% of Total Grant under Pooling of Assigned Revenue for the year 2022-23.

3. In the letter third read above, the Commissioner of Rural Development and Panchayat Raj has stated that, in G.O. (Ms) No.5, Rural Development and Panchayat (PR-1(1)) Department, dated 02.02.2023 the Government have issued an order to Pooled Assigned Revenues from Surcharge on Stamp Duty at the State level and to distribute the same to undertake state level priority schemes and to release portion of the fund to Rural Local Bodies. In the Government Order, the sanction has been accorded for the total sum of Rs.1003,00,46,610/- under Pooling of Assigned Revenue for the year 2022-23 and permission has also been accorded to assign One-third of the total pooled amount to Village Panchayats and Panchayat Unions and Two-third amount for Priority Schemes in rural areas in the financial year 2022-23 as was done in the year 2021-22.

4. He has also stated that, the Government has ordered to follow the existing ratio of 67:33 for the allocation of funds under Pooled Assigned Revenue Village Panchayats and Panchayat Unions respectively shall be continued in the financial year 2022-23 and the permission has been accorded for the release of one-third of the Pooled Assigned Revenue to Village Panchayats and Panchayat Unions based on the latest SFC formula and two-third of the pooled amount to Scheme Component Fund for implementing priority works in rural areas.

5. He has further stated that, in G.O. (Ms) No.5, Rural Development and Panchayat (PR-1(1)) Department, dated 02.02.2023 the Government have issued orders for the release of Rs.501,50,23,305/- out of Rs.1003,00,46,610/- as 50% of the total sanctioned amount under Pooled Assigned Revenue for the year 2022-23 and the same has been drawn and sent to the concerned as per the Government Order. Now, it is submitted that a sum of Rs.501,50,23,305/- being 50% of the total amount sanction has to be released as second instalment under Pooled Assigned Revenue for the year 2022-23.

6. The Commissioner of Rural Development and Panchayat Raj has therefore requested the Government to issue necessary orders for the release of Rs.501,50,23,305/- (Rupees Five hundred and one crore fifty lakh twenty three thousand three hundred and five only) as second instalment being 50% of the total amount sanction under Pooled Assigned Revenue for the year 2022-23 and to authorize the Commissioner of Rural Development and Panchayat Raj to draw the above amount and release one third of the allocation to Village Panchayats and Panchayat Unions (in the ratio of 67:33) based on the latest SFC formula and retain the balance two third of the total allocation for implementation of Specific Development Schemes in rural areas as per the guidelines.

7. The Government after careful examination of the proposal of the Commissioner of Rural Development and Panchayat Raj have decided to accord sanction for release of a sum of Rs.501,50,23,305/- (Rupees Five hundred and one crore fifty lakh twenty three thousand three hundred and five only) as second instalment being 50% of the total amount sanction under Pooled Assigned Revenue to Rural Local Bodies for the year 2022-23 subject to the following conditions:-

"Pooled Assigned Revenue will be used towards Mudalvarin Grama Salai Membattu Thittam and AGAMT for the year 2022-2023".

8. The amount sanctioned in para '7' above shall be debited to the following heads of account:-

The Commissioner of Rural Development and Panchayat Raj is authorize to draw the above amount and release of entire one third of the allocation between the Village Panchayats and Panchayat Unions in the ratio of 67:33 based on the latest State Finance Commission (SFC) formula and retain the balance two third of the total allocation for implementation of Specific Development Schemes in rural areas as per the guidelines.
