Rural Development and Panchayat Raj Department – 6th State Finance Commission Grant – Revised sanction and release of Rs.941,00,00,000/- towards Capital Grant for the year 2022-23 as per the Sixth State Finance Commission Recommendation - Orders - Issued.

ORDER:

In the Government Order 1st read above, the Government have sanctioned a sum of Rs.1,451,67,84,000/- as Capital Grant Fund under the State Finance Commission Devolution Grant and release the first installment of Rs.725,83,92,000/- as being the 50% of total grant under Capital Grant Fund for the year 2022-23. Subject to the condition that the present release will be adjusted as per 6th State Finance Commission Recommendations, once it is finalized.

- 2. In the letter 2nd read above, the Commissioner of Rural Development and Panchayat Raj has requested the Government to sanction and to release the second installment of Rs.725,83,92,000/- as being the remaining 50% of total Grant under the Capital Grant Fund for the year 2022-23.
- 3. In the Government letter 3rd read above, the Commissioner of Rural Development and Panchayat Raj has been requested to send the revised proposal to Government based on the Sixth State Finance Commission Recommendation for release the Capital Grant Fund for the year 2022-23.
- 4. In the letter 5th read above, the Commissioner of Rural Development and Panchayat Raj has stated that in G.O. (Ms) No.139, Rural Development and Panchayat Raj (PR-1) Department, dated 20.12.2022, the Government issued a

order by sanctioning an amount of Rs.1451,67,84,000/- under Capital Grant Fund for the year 2022-23 and ordered for release of Rs.725,83,92,000/- as first installment by following the recommendations of Fifth State Finance Commission. But in due course of the drawl, the Government withheld the release of Rs.725,83,92,200/-citing the reason of adoption of Sixth State Finance Commission's devolution pattern for the current year. The Sixth State Finance Commission constituted by the Government has submitted its recommendations with reference to funds, functions and functionaries of Local Bodies. Based on which, the Government has accepted majority of the recommendations. In Continuation of this, the Government has issued a letter 3rd read above, by intimating component wise Revised allocation for the year 2022-23 under Sixth State Finance Commission after duly considering the grant sanctioned under the Fifth State Finance Commission.

5. He has also stated that the Government in its letter 3rd read above, has informed that "as per the 6th State Finance Commission (SFC) Recommendations, the Capital Grant Funding to Rural Local Bodies, has been changed vastly. As far as its impact on the Budget is concerned, the following provisions have been made in the RE 2022-23 under the new heads of account". Further the Government has intimated the following new heads of account with proportionate fund allocation against them in the following table:-

As per the Government letter 3rd read above, a sum of Rs.725,83,92,000 has already been sanctioned vide G.O. (Ms) No.139, Rural Development and Panchayat Raj Department, dated 20.12.2022, (under the head 3604 00 200 BP) may be quashed. In lieu of that a new Government order is requested by following the Sixth State Finance Commission recommendations.

6. He has further stated that, Rural road components of Rs.120 crore, and a balance amount of Rs.941 crore has been distributed across the heads grouped under Capital Grant Funding Considering the award period of 2022-23 represented now as per the RE 2022-23 provisions and the provisions already made under 3604 00 200 BP to the tune of Rs.1451,67,84,000 in BE 2022-23 is nullified in

RE 2022-23 is proposed. The Government in its schematic devolution has dovetailed the grant for implementation of the schemes as detailed below:-

As mentioned above, the Government has dovetailed an amount of Rs.500 crore for implementation of the Scheme MGSMT from Capital Grant Fund and Rs.300 Crore for implementation of AGAMT 2.0 Scheme vide letter 3rdread above.

- 7. The Commissioner of Rural Development and Panchayat Raj has further requested the Government to issue orders on the following:-
 - (i) To quash the G.O. (Ms) No.139, Rural Development and Panchayat Raj Department, dated 20.12.2022, (under the head 3604 00 200 BP) issued in respect of Capital Grant Fund.
 - (ii) To issue orders for the sanction and release of a total sum of Rs.1061,00,00,000/- (Rupees One thousand sixty one crore only) towards Capital Grant for the year 2022-23 as per the Sixth State Finance Commission recommendations.
 - (iii) to authorize the Commissioner of Rural Development and Panchayat Raj to draw the amount of Rs.1061,00,00,000/- (Rupees One thousand sixty one crore only) towards Capital Grant for the year 2022-23.
 - (iv) To issue orders to dovetail an amount of Rs.500 crore for implementation of the Scheme MGSMT from Capital Grant Fund and Rs.300 Crore for implementation of AGAMT 2.0 Scheme as per the table mentioned above.

- (v) To release the grant to the respective scheme nodal accounts of the Department / Sections to undertake the works as per the respective scheme guidelines.
- 8. The Government have carefully examined the proposal of the Commissioner of Rural Development and Panchayat Raj in detail and decided to accept the same and issue the following orders:
 - a) G.O. 1st read above is superseded, since the 6th State Finance Commission has recommended to adopt the new devolution pattern.
 - b) Sanction is accorded to release Rs.941,00,00,000/- (Rupees Nine hundred and forty one crore only) towards Capital Grant for the year 2022-23 as per the Sixth State Finance Commission recommendations.
 - c) Permission is given to dovetail an amount of Rs.500 crore for implementation of the Scheme MGSMT as ordered in Government Order 4th read above from Capital Grant Fund and Rs.300 Crore for implementation of AGAMT 2.0 Scheme as per the table mentioned at para 6 above.
 - d) Permission is given to release the grant to the respective scheme nodal accounts of the Department / Sections to undertake the works as per the respective scheme guidelines.
- 9. The amount sanctioned in para '8' above shall be debited under the following heads of account:-
