



## **ABSTRACT**

Rural Development and Panchayat Raj Department – Grants – Award under Fifteenth Finance Commission – Release of Rs.799.80 crore towards first installment of Tied Grant for the year 2021-22 to Rural Local Bodies – Sanction – Orders – Issued.

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### **ORDER:**

In the Government Order first read above, orders were issued releasing an amount of Rs.901.75 Crore towards 50% of Tied Grant for Rural Local Bodies as second installment for the year 2020-21 as recommended by Fifteenth Central Finance Commission.

2. In the letter 2<sup>nd</sup> read above, the Ministry of Finance, Department of Expenditure, Government of India, has released a sum of Rs.799.80 crore towards first installment of Tied Grant for the year 2021-22 recommended by the Fifteenth Finance Commission.

3. In the letter third read above the Director of Rural Development and Panchayat Raj has stated that the Ministry of Finance, Government of India has allocated a sum of Rs.2666.00 crore as Rural Local Body Grants for the year 2021-22 under 15<sup>th</sup> Central Finance Commission for Rural Local Bodies in Tamil Nadu. Out of this Rs.1599.60 crore is sanctioned as Tied Grant (60%) and Rs.1066.40 crore as Untied Grant (40%).

4. He has also stated that necessary provisions have been made in Revised Budget Estimate 2021-22 separately for Tied Grant and Untied Grant under the following heads of accounts pertaining to 15<sup>th</sup> Central Finance Commission Grant for Rural Local Bodies for the year 2021-22.

5. The Director of Rural Development and Panchayat Raj has further stated that the Fifteenth Finance Commission has recommended that the Grants for Rural Local Bodies (RLBs) are in two parts, namely, Basic and Tied Grants, in the ratio of 40: 60 from the year 2021-22.

**Basic Grant: (40%)**

Basic Grants are untied and can be used by RLBs for location specific felt needs, except for salary or other established expenditure.

**Tied Grant: (60%)**

Tied Grant is to be used for the basic services of a) Sanitation and maintenance of open defecation free (ODF) status and b) Supply of drinking water, Rain water harvesting and recycling. The Local bodies shall, as far as possible earmark one half of these tied grants each to these two critical services. However, if any local body has fully saturated the needs of one category, it can utilize the funds for the other category.

The Fifteenth Finance Commission has also recommended that its Grant, Basic and Tied, should be distributed to all the tiers of the Panchayats in the states on the basis of the accepted recommendation of the latest State Finance Commission (SFC) and also in conformity to the bands recommended by XV FC.

In this context, the following sharing/ Distribution formula have been approved by the Government in respect of Rural Local Bodies in Tamil Nadu.

- The vertical sharing ratio among three tiers of Rural Local Bodies will be **5:15:80 for District Panchayats, Panchayat Unions and Village Panchayats respectively.**
- Horizontal Distribution of Fifteenth Finance Commission Grant within the tier will be as per the Horizontal Distribution formula as recommended by Fifth State Finance Commission formula given below:
  - a) Population as per 2011 census : 60%
  - b) Area : 15%
  - c) SC/ST population : 15%
  - d) Per capita consumption Expenditure Distance : 10%

6. The Director of Rural Development and Panchayat Raj has added that the Ministry of Finance, Government of India in its release order dated 27.08.2021 has released an amount of Rs.799.80 crore towards First installment of Tied Grant for the year 2021-22 under the 15<sup>th</sup> Finance Commission Grant and ordered to transfer the above grant amount within ten working days of receipt from the Union Government without any deduction.

7. He has therefore requested the Government to release an amount of Rs.799,80,00,000/- (Rupees Seven Hundred and Ninety Nine crore and Eighty Lakh only) towards first installment of Tied Grant for the year 2021-22 under the 15<sup>th</sup> Central Finance Commission Grant and to authorize him to draw and disburse the above amount to 12,525 Village Panchayats, 388 Block Panchayats and 36 District Panchayats. The detailed state specific guidelines issued to utilise the grant vide G.O. (Ms) No.18, Rural Development and Panchayat Raj (PR-1) Department, dated 03.02.2021 should be followed scrupulously for both tied and untied components.

8. The Government after careful examination of the proposal of the Director of Rural Development and Panchayat Raj accord sanction for a sum of Rs.799,80,00,000/- (Rupees Seven Hundred and Ninety Nine crore and Eighty Lakh only) towards first installment of Tied Grant for the year 2021-22 as recommended by Fifteenth Central Finance Commission.

9. The expenditure sanctioned at para 8 shall be debited to the following heads of account:-

10. Necessary additional funds of Rs.101,95,00,000/- will be provided in RE/FMA 2021-2022. However this expenditure shall be brought to the notice of Legislature by specific inclusion in the Supplementary Estimates 2021-2022. He is also directed to include this item of expenditure while sending the budget proposal for RE/FMA 2021-2022 and also send necessary draft explanatory note for inclusion of this expenditure in the Supplementary Estimate 2021-2022 to Government in Finance (RD/BG-I) Department at the appropriate time without fail.

11. The Director of Rural Development and Panchayat Raj is authorized to draw and disburse the amount sanctioned at para 8 above immediately to the 12,525 Village Panchayats and 388 Panchayat Unions and 36 District Panchayats without any delay so as to avoid penal interest. The Director of Rural Development and Panchayat Raj is directed to follow the operational guidelines issued by the Ministry of Finance in its letter No.15(4)FC- XV/FCD/ 2020-25 dated 27.08.2021 for the implementation of the recommendations on Rural Local Body(RLB) grants contained in Chapter 5(Local Body Grants) of the 15<sup>th</sup> Finance Commission (FC-XV) Report.

12. This order issues with the concurrence of Finance Department vide its U.O. No.37375/Fin(RD)/2021,dated 07.09.2021 and ASL No.392 (Three hundred and ninety two)


