



## **ABSTRACT**

Rural Development and Panchayat Raj Department – Grants – Award under Fifteenth Finance Commission – Release of Rs.828.30 crore towards first installment of Tied Grant for the year 2022-23 to Rural Local Bodies – Sanction – Orders – Issued.

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### **ORDER:**

In the Government Order first read above, the Government have approved the guidelines for the utilization of the grants under 15<sup>th</sup> Central Finance Commission Grant to Rural Local Bodies.

2. In the Government Order Second read above, the Government have released for a sum of Rs.799,80,00,000/- towards second installment of Tied Grant for the year 2021-22 as recommended by the Fifteenth Central Finance Commission.

3. In the letter third read above, the Ministry of Finance, Department of Expenditure, Government of India, has released a sum of Rs.828.30 crore towards first installment of Tied Grant for the year 2022-23 recommended by the Fifteenth Central Finance Commission.

4. In the letter fourth read above the Commissioner of Rural Development and Panchayat Raj has informed that the Ministry of Finance, Government of India has stated that a sum of Rs.2761.00 crore has been allocated as Rural Local Body Grants for the year 2022-23 under 15<sup>th</sup> Central Finance Commission for Rural Local Bodies in Tamil Nadu. Out of this Rs.1656.60 crore is sanctioned as Tied Grant (60%) and Rs.1104.40 crore as Untied Grant(40%).

5. He has also stated that necessary provisions have been made in Budget Estimate 2022-23 separately for Tied Grant and Untied Grant under the following head of accounts pertaining to 15<sup>th</sup> Central Finance Commission Grant for Rural Local Bodies for the year 2022-23.

6. The Commissioner of Rural Development and Panchayat Raj has further stated that the Fifteenth Central Finance Commission has recommended that the Grants for Rural Local Bodies (RLBs) are in two parts, namely, Basic and Tied Grants, in the ratio of 40: 60 from the year 2021-22.

**Basic Grant:(40%)**

Basic Grants are untied and can be used by RLBs for location specific felt needs, except for salary or other established expenditure.

**Tied Grant:(60%)**

Tied Grant is to be used for the basic services of a) Sanitation and maintenance of open defecation free (ODF) status and b) Supply of drinking water, Rain water harvesting and recycling. The Local bodies shall, as far as possible earmark one half of these tied grants each to these two critical services. However, if any local body has fully saturated the needs of one category, it can utilize the funds for the other category.

The Fifteenth Central Finance Commission has also recommended that its Grant, viz. Basic and Tied, should be distributed to all the tiers of the Panchayats in the states on the basis of the accepted recommendation of the latest State Finance Commission (SFC) and also in conformity to the bands recommended by XV FC.

In this context, the following sharing/ Distribution formula have been approved by the Government in respect of Rural Local Bodies in Tamil Nadu.

- The vertical sharing ratio among three tiers of Rural Local Bodies will be **5:15:80 for District Panchayats, Panchayat Unions and Village Panchayats respectively.**
- Horizontal Distribution of the Fifteenth Central Finance Commission Grant within the tier will be as per the Horizontal Distribution formula as



recommended by the Fifth State Finance Commission formula given below:-

7. The Commissioner of Rural Development and Panchayat Raj has added that the Government of India has released an amount of Rs. 828.30 Crore as first installment of Tied component for the year 2022-23.

8. The Commissioner of Rural Development and Panchayat Raj has therefore requested the Government to issue orders for the sanction and release an amount of Rs.828,30,00,000/- (Rupees Eight Hundred and Twenty eight crore and Thirty Lakh only) towards First instalment of Tied Grant for the year 2022-23 under the 15<sup>th</sup> Central Finance Commission Grant for 12,525 Village Panchayats, 388 Block Panchayats and 36 District Panchayats. The detailed state specific guidelines issued to utilise the grant vide G.O. (Ms) No.18, Rural Development and Panchayat Raj (PR-1) Department, dated 03.02.2021 should be followed scrupulously for both tied and untied components.

9. The Government after careful examination of the proposal of the Commissioner of Rural Development and Panchayat Raj accord sanction for an amount of Rs.828,30,00,000/- (Rupees Eight Hundred and Twenty eight crore and Thirty Lakh only) towards first installment of Tied Grant for the year 2022-23 as recommended by the Fifteenth Central Finance Commission.

10. The expenditure sanctioned at para 9 shall be debited to the following heads of account:-

The Commissioner of Rural Development and Panchayat Raj is directed to follow the operational guidelines on the subject issued by the Department of Expenditure vide OM NO.F. 15.(2) FC-XV/ FCD 2020-25 Dated 14.07.2021 for the implementation of the recommendations on Rural Local Body(RLB) grants.


