The following Act of the Tamil Nadu Legislative Assembly received the assent of the Governor on the 24th January 2018 and is hereby published for general information:—

ACT No. 3 OF 2018.

An Act further to amend the Tamil Nadu Panchayats Act, 1994.

BE it enacted by the Legislative Assembly of the State of Tamil Nadu in the Sixty-eighth Year of the Republic of India as follows:—

1. (1) This Act may be called the Tamil Nadu Panchayats (Amendment) Act, 2018.

Short title and commencement.

(2) It shall be deemed to have come into force on the 28th day of December 2017.

Tamil Nadu Act 21 of 1994.

2. In section 261-A of the Tamil Nadu Panchayats Act, 1994, for the expression "upto the 31st day of December 2017", the expression "upto the 30th day of June 2018" shall be substituted.

Amendment of section 261-A.

Tamil Nadu Ordinance 8 of 2017. 3. (1) The Tamil Nadu Panchayats (Third Amendment) Ordinance, 2017 is hereby repealed.

Repeal and saving.

Tamil Nadu Act 21 of 1994.

(2) Notwithstanding such repeal, anything done or any action taken under the Tamil Nadu Panchayats Act, 1994, as amended by the said Ordinance, shall be deemed to have been done or taken under the said Act, as amended by this Act.
