

ABSTRACT

Grants – State Finance Commission Grants for the year 2015-16 – Release of Rs.3568,96,15,714/- to Village Panchayats, Panchayat Unions and District Panchayats from the month of April 2015 to January 2016 – Orders – Issued.

ORDER:

In the Government order first read above as per the recommendations of Fourth State Finance Commission, the Government have ordered that the vertical sharing ratio for devolution of State Finance Commission Grant to rural and urban local bodies will be continued as 58:42. The Government have also ordered to apportion the devolution grant of the rural local bodies among the Village Panchayats, Panchayat Unions and District Panchayats in the ratio of 60:32:8.

- 2. The Director of Rural Development and Panchayat Raj in his letter second read above has sent necessary proposals for the release of State Finance Commission Grant to rural local bodies for the year 2015-16 and stated as follows:-
- (i) The State Government have made a provision in the Budget Estimate for Rs.5222.07 crore for the year 2015-16 as detailed below:-

ii. Village Panchayat - Minimum Grant & Population Grant: As per the Fourth State Finance Commission recommendations, the Government have ordered that the Minimum lumpsum Grant to Village Panchayats will be increased from Rs.3 lakh to Rs.5 lakh per Village Panchayat per year. This amount will be deducted from the balance share of State Finance Commission devolution intended for Village Panchayats as the first charge and distributed to all Village Panchayats on monthly basis. The balance amount from out of the share of Village Panchayats in the SFC devolution will be distributed on the horizontal sharing ratio as below:

a)	Total population (2011 Census)	60%
b)	SC/ST population	20%
c)	Area	20%

- iii. Panchayat Union Minimum Grant & Population Grant: As per the 4th SFC recommendations, the Government have ordered that the minimum grant of Rs.30 lakh per Panchayat Union per year will be continued for the award period and the balance amount entitled for Panchayat Union will be distributed based on Census 2011 population.
- iv. **District Panchayat Population Grant:** As per the 4th SFC recommendations, the amount entitled for District Panchayat will be distributed based on Census 2011 population.
- v. **Infrastructure Gap Filling Fund**: The Government have earmarked a sum of Rs.522,20,74,000/- in the Budget Estimate for Infrastructure Gap Filling Fund for the year 2015-16. The Director of Rural Development and Panchayat Raj has sent detailed proposal stating that the guidelines for utilisation of the Infrastructure Gap Filling Fund at District level and at State level will be sent to Government separately.
- 3. The DRD&PR has requested the Government to issue orders for release of the share of devolution grant to Village Panchayats, Panchayat Unions and District Panchayats in monthly instalments as detailed below:

The DRD&PR has also requested the Government to issue orders sanctioning the minimum grant of Rs.5 lakh per year at the rate of Rs.40,000/- per month from April 2015 to January 2016 (10 months) and Rs.50,000/- per month for February and March 2016 (2 months) to each Village Panchayat and Rs.30 lakh per year at the rate of Rs.2.50 lakh per month to each Panchayat Union in 12 monthly instalment as per the 4th State Finance Commission recommendation. The amount now required towards the minimum grant for Village Panchayats and Panchayat Unions for 12 months and population grant for Village Panchayats, Panchayat Union and District Panchayats for 10 months from April 2015 to January 2016 are as below:-

- 5. The Director of Rural Development and Panchayat Raj has also requested the Government to issue orders authorizing him to draw and disburse the amount to the three tier of Panchayat Raj Institutions and also to make necessary adjustments/deductions for committed expenditure such as pension commitment etc.
- 6. The Government have carefully examined the proposal of the Director of Rural Development and Panchayat Raj in the light of the orders issued in the Government order first read above and decided to release a sum of Rs.3568,96,15,714/- (Rupees Three thousand five hundred and sixty eight crore ninety six lakh fifteen thousand and seven hundred fourteen only) as State Finance Commission Grant to Village Panchayats, Panchayat Unions and District Panchayats from the months of April 2015 to January 2016 out of total allocation of State Finance Commission Grant of Rs.5222,07,36,000/- for the year 2015-16 as follows:-

- 8. The Director of Rural Development and Panchayat Raj is authorized to draw and disburse the amount sanctioned in para 6 above as per the recommendations of the Fourth State Finance Commission issued in the Government order first read above. The Director of Rural Development and Panchayat Raj is authorised to disburse the minimum grant of Rs.5.00 lakh per year at the rate of Rs.40,000/- per month from April 2015 to January 2016 (10 months) and Rs.50,000/- per month for February and March 2016 (2 months) to each Village Panchayat and Rs.30 lakh per year at the rate of Rs.2.50 lakh per month to each Panchayat Union in 12 monthly instalments. The minimum grant sanctioned to Village Panchayats shall be used for payment of Electricity consumption and Water charges so that these services do not suffer.
- 9. The Pay and Accounts Officer/Treasury Officers concerned are requested to admit and honor the bills as and when presented by the Director of Rural Development and Panchayat Raj, if they are found otherwise in order.
- 10. This order is issued with the concurrence of Finance Department vide its U.O. No.83/JS(AR)/2015, dated 27.04.2015.
