ORDER:

In the Government Order first read above, administrative sanction was accorded for construction of 20,000 houses including 8803 houses for the Tribal beneficiaries along with the detailed guidelines for the implementation of Chief Minister's Green House Scheme (CMGHS) for the year 2020-21 at an estimated cost of Rs.499.22 crore.

- 2. In the Government Order second read above, orders were issued releasing Rs.249,61,00,000/- being 50% of funds out of total fund allocation of Rs.499.22 Crore for the implementation of Chief Minister's Green House Scheme (CMGHS) for the year 2020-2021.
- 3. In the Government Order third read above, orders were issued releasing a sum of Rs.210,00,00,000/- (Rupees Two hundred and Ten crore only) out of the backlog amount of Rs.420 crore for the period upto 2019-20 for construction of the houses under Chief Minister's Solar Powered Green House Scheme (CMSPGHS).

- 4. In his proposal fourth read above, the Director of Rural Development and Panchayat Raj has requested the Government to release the balance 50% of the total cost of Rs.499.22 crore including Rs.39.61 crore intended for the additional allotment for Tribal beneficiaries and to issue necessary orders to release the funds so as to complete all the houses sanctioned under Chief Minister's Green House Scheme for the year 2020-21.
- 5. The Government, after detailed examination of the proposal of the Commissioner of Rural Development and Panchayat Raj, have decided to accord sanction and release a sum of Rs.39,61,00,000/- (Rupees Thirty Nine crore and sixty one lakh only) towards the additional allotment for Tribal beneficiaries under Chief Minister's Green House Scheme (CMGHS) for the year 2020-2021.
- 6. The amount sanctioned in para 5 above, shall be debited to the following Head of Account:-

2216 Housing – 03 Rural Housing – 796 Tribal Area Sub Plan – State' Expenditure – JF Special allocation for differential cost of housing for tribal families – 309 Grants-in-aid-03 Grants for Specific Schemes.
