4. In the letter fourth read above, the Director of Rural Development and Panchayat Raj has requested the Government to release the balance amount of Rs.100.00 crore in the Budget Estimates 2015-16 under NABARD RIDF-XX for speedy implementation of the Scheme.

Accordingly, the Government accord further financial sanction and release of Rs.100.00 crore (Rupees One Hundred crore only) for laying/upgradation of rural roads and construction of bridges under NABARD-RIDF XX.
