ORDER:

In the letter first read above, the Director of Rural Development and Panchayat Raj has sent an additional proposal under NABARD-RIDF XIX for laying/upgradation of 266 Rural Roads and for construction of 26 Bridges at the total cost of Rs.151.97 crore and this proposal was later revised for 53 Rura Roads and 26 Bridges at the total cost of Rs.56.21 crore and in the letter 2nd cited this revised proposal was forwarded by the Finance Department to NABARD for sanction of loan under NABARD-RIDF XIX.

- 2) In the letter 3rd read above, the Director of Rural Development and Panchayat Raj has sent another proposal for laying/upgradation of 537 Rural Roads for a length of 1095.44 KM to the total value of Rs.233.6971 crore under NABARD-RIDF XX and the same was forwarded by the linance Department to the NABARD for sanction of loan under NABARD-RIDF XX. In total, the Director or Rural Development and Panchayat Raj had sent two proposals for laying/upgradation of 590 Rural Roads and for construction of 26 Bridges at the total cost of Rs.339.9071 crore.
- 3) In the letter 4th read above, the Deputy General Manager, NABARD, has informed that the Project Sanctioning Committee (PSC) of NABARD, among other things, has accorded a sanction for laying/upgradation of 590 Rural Roads and for construction of 26 Bridges, at the total cost of Rs.339.9071 crore under NABARD-RIDF XX. The NABARD would provide loan to the tune of Rs.271.9249 crore, being 80 % of the total project cost.
- 4) Pursuant to the sanction accorded by the NABARD in the letter 4th ead above, the Government after careful examination accord administrative sanction for laying/upgradation of 590 Rural Roads and for construction of 26 Bridges at the total cost of Rs.339.9071 crore (Rupees Three Hundred Thirty Nine Crore Ninety Lakh and Seventy One Thousand Only) with loan assistance from the NABARD under Rural Infrastructure Development Fund-XX (RIDF-XX), as indicated in the Annexure-A and Annexure-B respectively to this order. Of the total project cost of Rs.339.9071 crore, the NABARD's loan component would be Rs.271.9249 crore and the State Government's share would be Rs.67.9822 crore. Orders pertaining to Financial Sanction and Release of funds for taking up the above works under NABARD RIDF XX will be issued separately.
- 5) The Director of Rural Development and Panchayat Raj is requested to closely monitor the works and to ensure the quality of works is maintained as per the specifications and norms already in force. In this regard, detailed instructions should be given to the District Collectors by the Director of Rural Development and Panchayat Raj. The Director of Rural Development and Panchayat Raj is also requested to ensure that any of the above sanctioned works are not included in any of the other Schemes of Rural Development and Panchayat Raj Department or any other Departments before finalizing tender.
