ORDER:

In the Government Order first read above, orders were issued for sanctioning of 268 posts for the implementation of Special Housing Programme for THANE affected districts and also authorizing the Commissioner of Rural Development and Panchayat Raj to make proportionate distribution of posts depending upon the number of houses sanctioned to Cuddalore and Villupuram Districts without exceeding the total number of posts sanctioned.

2. In the letter 2nd read above, the Commissioner of Rural Development and Panchayat Raj has stated that it is necessary to issue certain amendments to the Government Order first read above, for filling up of these sanctioned posts for the following reasons:

- (i) In Para 5 (ii) of Government Order first read above, it has been ordered that, "Except the post of Technical Assistant which can be recruited through Employment Exchange on consolidated pay of Rs.12,000 per month, all other posts to be filled up from the personnel of the Rural Development Department's staff strength." There is no post of Data Entry Operator in the Department. Therefore, these posts cannot be filled up from the personnel of the Rural Development and Panchayat Raj Department. Hence, he has requested the Government to permit him to fill up those posts through the Employment Exchange or Outsourcing by the District Collectors concerned.
- (ii) Due to large number of vacancies in the cadre of Assistant Engineers at present in the Rural Development and Panchayat Raj Department, filling up of these posts with the available strength is impossible. Therefore, these posts may be designated as Civil Engineers instead of Assistant Engineers

and may be filled up through Employment Exchange on consolidated salary of Rs.20,000/- with the following qualification by the Collectors concerned.

“A degree in Civil Engineering from a recognized University or a pass in section A and B examination (AMIE) conducted by the Institution of Engineers (India).”

They may be absorbed as Assistant Engineers in the available vacancy in the Rural Development and Panchayat Raj Department in future, after the completion of this project so as to ensure that there is no attrition and enable quick completion of houses to mitigate the sufferings of rural poor affected by Thane Cyclone.

(iii) The post of Technical Assistant which can be recruited through Employment Exchange on consolidated pay of Rs.12,000/- per month may also be absorbed as Overseer in Rural Development and Panchayat Raj Department after completion of this project in the available vacant post on seniority basis (Registration in the Employment Exchange).

(iv) The details provided in the column “Salary per month/per post” in the proposal is only indicative and showing the approximate annual financial commitment for each of the posts. The table with additional details to include the present pay band/consolidated salary and mode of recruitment, may be incorporated in para (4) of the said Government Order as suggested by him.

3. The Government after careful examination of the proposal of the Commissioner of Rural Development and Panchayat Raj, issue the following amendments to G.O.(Ms.)No. 105, RD&PR (SGS.II) Department, dated 9.11.2012:

- (i) The post of Data Entry Operators shall be filled up through outsourcing by the District Collectors concerned.
- (ii) The existing Table in para 4 of the Government Order first read above shall be replaced as given below:-

The scale of pay indicated therein are appropriate. However, the scale of pay of Assistant Engineers/Assistant Executive Engineers/Executive Engineers is presently contested in the Hon’ble High Court and the final verdict is pending. As such the scales of pay indicated in respect of the above posts is subject to the outcome of the result of the Writ Appeals preferred in this regard”.

The Government also order the following:

- (i) Regarding the post of Assistant Engineers, there is no change as ordered in the above Government Order. The existing strength shall be redeployed and if there are vacancies the same may be filled expeditiously as done in the past.
- (ii) The present 'Thane' posts will lapse automatically in one year and the suggestions for absorption regarding Assistant Engineers and Technical Assistants are not accepted.
- (iii) The scales of pay of Assistant Engineer/Assistant Executive Engineer/ Executive Engineer indicated above is subject to the outcome of the Writ Appeals preferred in this regard.

4. This order issues with the concurrence of the Finance Department vide its U.O. No.179/JS(AR)/13, dated 2.07.2013 and U.O. No.35557/CMPC/13, dated 3.07.2013.
