ORDER:

In the letter read above, the Director of Rural Development and Panchayat Raj has stated that as a measure to provide common infrastructure facilities in rural areas, it is proposed to construct Buildings for Anganwadi Centres to provide a congenial environment for intellectual development of small children(6 months to 6 years of age). In addition, these centres will provide health check-up and health education awareness for pregnant women and adolescent girls. The children studying in these centres will be provided with adequate ventilation and facilities like baby friendly toilets in these protected buildings. In order to attract the children, pictures of fruits, animals, birds will be painted in attractive colours on the walls of these buildings. Additional infrastructure facilities such as construction of play area, baby friendly toilet, compound wall and kitchen garden will be provided. Also, the provision of Ramp with hand rails and unisex accessible toilet will be provided for facilitating differently abled persons.

2. The Director of Rural Development and Panchayat Raj has also stated that the Gol has sent the Minutes of the of the Empowered Committee Meeting held on 28.02.2017 at Krishi Bhavan, New Delhi under the Chairmanship of Secretary, Ministry of Rural Development and has communicated the target for Focus Area Works for the FY 2017-18. In respect of Anganwadi Building, Government of India has instructed to take and complete 1537 works including 537 Spill over works of FY 2016-17 and 1000 Anganwadi Centre planned for the FY 2017-18. Further, in the Minutes it has been instructed that the district-wise targets for these works have to be entered online in MIS latest by 31st March, 2017 to ensure fund release. Hence, it is proposed to construct 1000 Anganwadi Centre Buildings at a unit cost of Rs.8.50 lakhs out of which Rs.5.00 lakhs will be allocated under MGNREGS, Rs.2.00 lakhs will be dovetailed from Social Welfare Department (ICDS) and Rs.1.5 lakh shall be alloted either from

Panchayat Union general fund or Panchayat general fund at a total cost of Rs.85 crore as per the Rural Schedule of Rates(RSoR) 2017-18.

- 3. The Director of Rural Development and Panchayat Raj has stated that the Labour material ratio will be 17:83. The material component for one Anganwadi Centre Building will be Rs.7.65 lakh and labour component will be Rs.0.85 lakh for generating 420 person days. Thus by constructing 1000 Anganwadi Centre Buildings 4.20 lakh of person days will be generated. The above person days will vary, if any deviation occurs during field execution. The labour component is to be met only from the MGNREGS fund.
- 4. Further, the Director of Rural Development and Panchayat Raj has stated that the labour component is to be met only from the MGNREGS fund and the fund from ICDS and from Panchayat union General fund or Panchayat General fund shall purely be utilized for material component. Further, the funding pattern for the 537 spill over works of 2016-17 will not be changed and the previous funding pattern will continue. The funding pattern for the construction of 1000 Anganwadi Centre Buildings for the year 2017-18 is worked out as follows:-

The Director of Rural Development and Panchayat Raj has also stated that the contribution from ICDS has to be ensured for Rs.20.00 Crore with the due approval of the Ministry of Women and Child Development. The Project Director, District Rural Development Agencies shall be directed to consult the Project Officer, ICDS/Social Welfare Department in the District, for identifying the location of AWC. Three Stage Photographs shall be taken (i)before execution, (ii)during execution and (iii)after completion of work. The Citizen Information Board shall be erected at every worksite as per the Suggestive Framework on MGNREGA Citizen Information Board communicated by MoRD, Gol. Geo tagging of the assets shall be done after completion of the work. All the works should have separate MGNREGS Work File (Checklist/ Contents) as per the instructions of Government of India.

- 6. The Director of Rural Development and Panchayat Raj has further informed that the labour and material ratio will be maintained at district level as 60:40 as envisaged in the amendment made to Schedule-I of MGNREGA vide Gol, MoRD Notification dated 21.07.2014, Director of Rural Development and Panchayat Raj has requested that he may be empowered to revise the type design for the construction for Anganwadi Centre Building, in consultation with ICDS/Social Welfare Department as and when required. The amount of Rs.2.00 lakhs from Social Welfare Department shall also be utilised for facilities like Kitchen garden, Play area, Compound wall, Paintings, etc.
 - 7. The Director of Rural Development and Panchayat Raj has therefore requested the Government to accord permission for the construction of 1000 Anganwadi Centres in convergence with Social Welfare Department at a total cost of Rs.85 Crore during the year 2017-18 under MGNREGS.
 - 8. The Government, after careful examination of the proposal of the Director of Rural Development and Panchayat Raj hereby accord sanction for the construction of 1000 new Anganwadi Centres in convergence with Social Welfare and Nutritious Meal Programme Department at a total cost of Rs.85 Crore during the year 2017-18 under MGNREGS.
 - 9. This order is issued with the concurrence of Finance Department vide it's U.O No 42351/RD/2017, dated 12.09.2017.
