ORDER:

The Honourable Minister for Municipal Administration and Rural Development, Implementation of Special Programme had announced in the floor of the Legislative Assembly on 04.06.2018 as follows:

“ஊரகப் பகுதிகளில் உள்ள விவசாயிகள் தங்கள் விளைப் பொருள்களை விற்பனை செய்யும் பொருட்டும், சுயஉதவிக் குழுக்களின் உற்பத்தி பொருட்களை சந்தைப்படுத்தும் வகையிலும், மாண்புமிகு இதயதெய்வம் புரட்சித்தலைவி அம்மா அவர்களின் ஆசியுடன், மாண்புமிகு முதலமைச்சர் அவர்களின் ஆணைப்படி, 2018-19 ஆம் நிதியாண்டில், ஊரகப்பகுதிகளில் 50 கிராம சந்தைகள் 20 கோடி ரூபாய் மதிப்பீட்டில் அமைக்கப்படும்.”

2. In the letter 2nd read above, the Director of Rural Development and Panchayat Raj has stated that Rural Village haats are marketing centres constructed for the benefit of rural farmers, artisans and SHGs. Rural Haats help in creation of better marketing facilities, enabling the rural poor to sell their products throughout the year, one stop shopping platform to the wholesalers, retailers/consumers by showcasing the range of local rural products, thereby improving socio-economic condition.

3. The Director of Rural Development and Panchayat Raj has also stated that the Construction of Village Haats is a permissible activity under Para 7.7 of Annual Master Circular 2018-19 of MGNREGA and enlisted as S.No. 252 of Restructured list of permissible works under the Category – D of Assets, communicated by the Government of India. The Director of Rural Development and Panchayat Raj has therefore proposed to construct 50 nos. of Village Haats during the year 2018-19 at an estimated total cost of Rs.20 Crore under MGNREGS. The unit cost for Village Haat is Rs.40 Lakh.

4. The Director of Rural Development and Panchayat Raj has formulated the following procedure for selection and execution of work :-

- (i) Village Haats shall be constructed at the existing place of marketing in the villages i.e. places where weekly shandis/haats already exist.
- (ii) The land for the proposed Village Haat must be owned by the Gram Panchayat/Government.
- (iii) The Village Haats should not be constructed in private lands.
- (iv) The Village Haats shall be constructed at locations which have the potential for attracting large number of visitors.
- (v) Before finalising the locations, the TNSLRM/Community based organisations like village poverty reduction committee (VPRC)/Panchayat level Federation (PLFs) officials and farmers producer organisations or farmers producer groups shall be consulted.

The Village Haats will have the following basic facilities;

- Open raised platforms,
- Covered platforms,
- Toilets (separate facilities for women and men),
- Drinking water facility,
- Interlocking Paver block,
- Office block,
- Compound Wall with Gates,
- Rainwater Harvesting Structure,
- Storage Room,
- Garbage bins,
- Parking Facility.

Non Negotiable Items

1. Citizen Information Board shall be kept at the work site in 3 X 4 feet with all necessary information as per the framework given by the Government of India vide Ref No: k11023/1/2017 – MGNREGA (IV), MoRD, Dated 07.04.2017. Since this is a community type structure, the cost of Citizen Information Board will be fixed at Rs.4,500/- per unit. The cost of the information board shall be included in the estimate itself.
2. Geo Tagging of the Assets shall be done for all 3 stages namely Before, During and After completion of the work.
3. MGNREGS work file (Checklist / Contents) as per the instructions of Gol, vide Ref no:J11017/6/2016 – MGNREGA (VII), MoRD, Dt 21.12.2016 has to be maintained for all works.
4. The Rural Schedule of Rate finalized in G.O.Ms. No.56, RD&PR (CGS.1) Department, Dated: 17.04.2018 shall be adopted. In case of any revision made in Rural Schedule of Rates in future, the same shall be adopted.
5. The Director of Rural Development and Panchayat Raj has stated that the estimated total cost is Rs.20.00 crore and unit cost for construction of Village Haat is Rs.40 Lakh. The labour and material cost ratio is 6.20:93.80. The Director of Rural Development and Panchayat Raj has worked out the funding pattern for construction of 50 Village Haats under MGNREGS for the year 2018-2019 as follows:-

6. The Director of Rural Development and Panchayat Raj has therefore, requested permission for construction of 50 Village Haats at a total cost of Rs.20.00 crore under MGNREGS for the year 2018-19.

7. The Government, after careful examination of the proposal of the Director of Rural Development and Panchayat Raj, accord permission for the construction of 50 Village Haats at a total cost of Rs.20.00 crore under MGNREGS during the year 2018-19 based on the guidelines issued in G.O.(Ms) No.34, Rural Development and Panchayat Raj(CGS.1) Department, Dated 04.03.2014 subject to the condition that the Financial sanction shall be approved after getting the release of Central share.

8. This order is issued with the concurrence of Finance Department vide its U.O.No.34163/RD/18, dated 16.07.2018.
