

## **ABSTRACT**

MGNREGS – Announcement of the Hon'ble Minister (MA and RD and Impln of Spl Prog) on the Floor of the Legislative Assembly on 04.06.2018 - Construction of Compound Wall / Flood Control and Protection Wall to Panchayat Union Elementary and Middle Schools in rural areas to a length of 200 Kms. at a total cost of Rs.107 crore under MGNREGS for the year 2018-19 - Permission accorded - Guidelines approved - Orders issued.

## ORDER:

The Honourable Minister for Municipal Administration and Rural Development, Implementation of Special Programme had announced on the floor of the Legislative Assembly on 04.06.2018 as follows:

"மாண்புமிகு இதயதெய்வம் புரட்சித்தலைவி அம்மா அவர்களின் ஆசியுடன், மாண்புமிகு முதலமைச்சர் அவர்களின் ஆணைப்படி, ஊரகப் பகுதிகளில் உள்ள ஊராட்சி ஒன்றிய ஆரம்பப்பள்ளி மற்றும் நடுநிலைப்பள்ளி வளாகங்களுக்கு 2018—19ஆம் நிதியாண்டில், 200 கி.மீ. நீளத்திற்கு சுற்றுச்சுவர் மற்றும் வெள்ளத் தடுப்புச் சுவர் 107 கோடி ரூபாய் மதிப்பீட்டில் கட்டப்படும்".

2. In the letter 2<sup>nd</sup> read above the Director of Rural Development and Panchayat Raj has stated that the Revised Schedule-I of the National Rural Employment Guarantee Act, 2005 Paragraph 4 (1) IV Category-D: Rural Infra Structure provides "works for restoration of essential public infrastructure and as per the permissible list of works, the restoration of Compound Wall for Government Schools as Community Asset is allowed. In Tamil Nadu, the Government Elementary and Middle schools are one of

the important Rural assets which need to be strengthened by developing additional infrastructure like compound wall, for the safety of students.

- 3. The Director of Rural Development and Panchayat Raj has also stated that the construction of Compound wall to Government Elementary and Middle School Buildings in Rural area is a permitted activity enlisted SI. No. 39 of Para 7.2.1 "Restructuring of list of permissible works" under the Annual Master Circular 2018-19 of MGNREGA.
- 4. Further, the Director of Rural Development and Panchayat Raj has stated that School Education Department has sent a requisition to Rural Development and Panchayat Raj Department to construct school compound wall to a length of 1650 kms in various Government Elementary and Middle Schools in Tamil Nadu to protect the school children from strangers and animals the school property from vandalism and floods and thereby ensure a safe environment to the school children of Government Elementary and Middle Schools in rural areas. Hence, based on the request of the School Education Department, it is proposed to construct Compound Wall to the Panchayat Union Elementary and Middle Schools in rural areas to a length of 200 Kms at a total cost of Rs.107 crore under MGNREGS during the year 2018-19.
- 5. The Director of Rural Development and Panchayat Raj has stated that the detailed estimate, based on the RSoR 2018-19, cost of construction of 1km length of compound wall will be Rs. 53.50 Lakh. The labour and material ratio is 9.80:90.20. The labour cost is borne 100% by Government of India and the material component is shared between the Central and State at the ratio of 75:25. The Director of Rural Development and Panchayat Raj has worked funding pattern for Construction of Compound Wall / Flood Control and Protection Wall to Panchayat Union Elementary and Middle Schools in rural areas. at a total cost of Rs.107 crore during the year 2018-19 under MGNREGS as below:

The Director of Rural Development and Panchayat Raj has therefore requested the Government for construction of Compound Wall / Flood Control and Protection Wall to Panchayat Union Elementary School and Panchayat Union Middle School Buildings in rural areas to a length of 200 Kms at a total cost of Rs.107 crore during the year 2018-19 under MGNREGS and approve the guidelines therefor.

- 7. The Government, after careful examination of the proposal of the Director of Rural Development and Panchayat Raj, accord permission for Construction of Compound Wall / Flood Control and Protection Wall to Panchayat Union Elementary School and Panchayat Union Middle School Buildings in rural areas to a length of 200 Kms at a total cost of Rs.107 crore and approved the guidelines annexed to this order, subject to the condition that the Financial sanction shall be approved after getting the release of Central share.
- 8. This order is issued with the concurrence of Finance Department vide its U.O.No. 46663 / Finance (RD) / 2018, dated 01.10.2018.

# GUIDELINES FOR CONSTRUCTION OF COMPOUND WALL TO THE PANCHAYAT UNION ELEMENTARY AND MIDDLE SCHOOLS UNDER MGNREGS

# (G.O(Ms) No.162, Rural Development and Panchayat Raj (CGS.1) Department, dated 16.11.2018)

The Revised Schedule I of the National Rural Employment Guarantee Act, 2005 Paragraph 4 (1) IV Category-D: Rural Infra Structure provides "works for restoration of essential public infrastructure and as per the permissible list of works under construction of Compound Wall for Government Schools as Community Asset is allowed. In Tamil Nadu, the Government Elementary and Middle schools are one of the important Rural assets which need to be strengthened by developing additional infrastructure like compound wall, for the safety of students.

#### Selection Criteria:

- The Compound Wall shall be constructed for Panchayat Union Elementary and Middle Schools only which are located in Village Panchayat area and also under the maintenance of Panchayat Union.
- The Priority list of Schools and length of Compound Wall shall be obtained from the Chief Educational Officer or the District Elementary Educational Officer of the concerned districts.
- The priority shall be for the schools located in Mission Antyodaya villages, Sansad Adarsh Gram Yojna (SAGY) Villages identified by the Hon'ble Member of Parliament, and SC/ST/ Hilly area/Villages.
- The priority shall be given to schools based on the students strength, schools abutting
  the road and the schools already covered by compound wall on the two sides by any
  other Schemes.

#### Non-Negotiable Items:

- 1. Citizen Information Board shall be kept at the work site in 3 X 4 feet with all necessary information as per the framework given by the Government of India vide Ref No: k11023 /1 / 12017 MGNREGA (IV), MORD, Dated 07.04.2017. Since this is a community type structure, the cost of Citizen Information Board will be fixed at Rs.4,500/- per unit. The cost of the Citizen Information Board shall be included in the estimate itself.
- 2. Geo Tagging of the Assets shall be done for all 3 stages namely Before, During and After completion of the work.
- 3. MGNREGS work file (Checklist / Contents) as per the instructions of GoI, vide Ref no: J11001017/6/12016 MGNREGA (VII), MORD, Dt 21.12.2016 has to be maintained for all works.
- 4. The Rural Schedule of Rates finalised in G.O.(Ms). No.56, RD&PR (CGS.1) Department, Dated:17.4.2018 shall be adopted. In case of any revision made in Rural Schedule of Rates (RSoR) in future, the same shall be adopted.
