ORDER:

In the G.O. first read above, the Government have issued detailed guidelines for the implementation of Solid Waste Management (SWM) activities in select 7,000 Village Panchayats in II Phase and for strengthening infrastructure facilities in the 2,000 Village Panchayats that have already been taken up in the first phase at a total cost of Rs.300 crore.

2. The Director of Rural Development and Panchayat Raj in the letter second read above, has stated that in pursuance of orders issued in the above G.O., detailed instructions have been issued to the District Collectors regarding the implementation of Solid Waste Management activities in Phase II Panchayats.

3. The Director of Rural Development and Panchayat Raj has also stated that in this connection feedback has been received from the districts requesting additional facilities citing certain constraints as given below:

1. In view of space constraints in most of the Panchayats, installation of Segregation cum storage Sheds with bigger dimension is difficult. Therefore, Segregation cum storage Sheds with smaller dimension is sufficient for carrying out the needed activities in the sheds.

2. In order to maintain streets of Village Panchayats clean and tidy, Garbage Collection Bins need to be placed in the streets, especially in Street junctions, Places with floating population, Commercial Centers, Educational Institutions, etc. Further, Common collection locations for Thooimai Kaavalars is required for storing in a particular place before transporting to dumping sites.
3. Peri-urban areas have special requirements for collection, segregation and disposal of wastes in view of higher quantum of garbage and space constraints. Therefore these Panchayats require advanced technologies solutions to address these problems.
4. The Director of Rural Development and Panchayat Raj has therefore proposed the following amendments to the guidelines issued in G.O.(Ms) No.10, RD&PR(CG.S.1) Department, dated 20.1.2016 :
