ORDER:

In the letter 1st read above, the Government of India have communicated the physical target of 1,30,214 houses for the year 2017-18 under Pradhan Mantri Awaas Yojana(Gramin).

2. In the letter 2nd read above, the Government of India have sanctioned a sum of Rs.487.52 crore towards the 1st installment of Central share including 4% administrative cost under PMAY(G) 2017-18.

3. In the Government Order 3rd read above, the Government have accorded sanction for the release of Rs.812,53,53,440 as 1st Installment towards central and State share under Pradhan Mantri Awaas Yojana(Gramin) for the year 2017-18, leaving a balance amount of the 1st installment of State Additional fund for RCC Roofing cost to the tune of Rs.325,53,50,000.

4. In the letter 4th read above, the Director of Rural Development and Panchayat Raj has stated that as on date, most of the houses taken up under Pradhan Mantri Awaas Yojana(Gramin) 2017-18 are in advance stages of progress. As per AwaasSoft report dated 11.12.2018 for Pradhan Mantri Awaas Yojana (Gramin) 2017-2018, the details of

bills paid to beneficiaries and house completion are detailed below:-

1 st Installment bills paid (Basement)	79,143
2 nd Installment bills paid (Lintel level)	49,956
3 rd Installment bills paid (Roof laid)	34,255
4 th Installment bills paid (Completed)	20,678
5 th Houses completed (Physically completed)	24,738

5. The Director of Rural Development and Panchayat Raj has therefore requested the Government to accord sanction for a sum of Rs.325,53,50,000/- as 1st Installment of State Additional Fund for RCC Roofing cost under Pradhan Mantri Awaas Yojana (Gramin) for the year 2017-18.

6. The Government, after careful examination of the proposal of the Director of Rural Development and Panchayat Raj, accord sanction for a sum of Rs.95.76 Crore (Rupees Ninety five Crore and Seventy six Lakh only) towards 1st installment of State Additional Fund for RCC Roofing Cost under PMAY(G) for the year 2017-18.

7. The expenditure sanctioned in para 6 above shall be debited under the following heads of account:-
