



### ABSTRACT

Schemes - Pradhan Mantri Awaas Yojana (Gramin) – Release of Rs.200,23,71,000/- (Rupees Two Hundred Crore Twenty Three Lakh Seventy One Thousand only) towards programme fund for Schedule Tribe category which includes Central and State share and to release the Central Share (60%) of Rs. 120,14,22,600/- (Rupees One Hundred and Twenty Crore Fourteen Lakh Twenty Two Thousand Six Hundred only) and the corresponding State matching Share (40%) of Rs.80,09,48,400/- (Rupees Eighty Crore Nine Lakh Forty Eight Thousand Four Hundred only) excluding Admin cost as 1<sup>st</sup> tranche of 1<sup>st</sup> Instalment for the year 2022-23 - Orders – Issued.

### ORDER:

In the reference 1<sup>st</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> read above, the Ministry of Rural Development, Government of India have released a sum of Rs.891.126 crore (excluding admin cost)



as one fourth of the balance amount entitled for the year 2018-19 and one fourth of funds against target of 2,00,000 houses for 2019-20 and 2,89,820 houses for 2021-22 towards 1<sup>st</sup> Tranche of 1<sup>st</sup> installment of Central Assistance during March, 2022 as follows:-

2. Subsequently, in the reference 2<sup>nd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> read above, the State Government of Tamil Nadu have released a sum of Rs.1485,21,00,000/- towards 1<sup>st</sup> tranche of 1<sup>st</sup> Instalment for the year 2021-22 which includes Central Share of Rs.891.126 crore and the corresponding State matching Share of Rs.594.084 crore and the same has been drawn and credited in the State Nodal Account.

3. Accordingly, the Ministry of Rural Development, Government of India was requested to release a sum of Rs.891.3672 crore out of Rs.2673.8604 crore for the year 2018-19, 2019-20 & 2021-22 after utilizing 81.43% (as on 07.07.2022) of programme fund released by the Government during the F.Y. 2021-22 & 2022-23. Accordingly, in the reference 7<sup>th</sup> read above, the Ministry of Rural Development, Government of India have released a sum of Rs. 667.457 crore out of Rs.2673.8604 crore towards programme fund excluding admin cost as 1<sup>st</sup>Tranche of 1<sup>st</sup>installment of Central Assistance for the year 2022-23 as detailed below:

4. Further, in the para 4 & 5 of the order issued in the reference 7<sup>th</sup> read above, the Ministry of Rural Development, Government of India has stated as;

- (i) *It is reiterated that while allocating targets to Districts, State should follow the formula prescribed by Ministry. It is clarified that earmarked Targets for SC, ST and Minority cannot be diverted to General category. Only SC and ST targets can be interchanged if there are sufficient justifications.*
- (ii) *The State Government will transfer the Central Share received in its account in the RBI to the concerned State Nodal Account (SNA) within a period of 21 days of its receipt. The central share shall not be diverted to the Personal Deposit (PD) account or any other account by the State Government. Corresponding State Share should be released as early as possible and not later than 40 days of release of the Central Share. The funds will be maintained in the Single Nodal Account of PMAY-G and State Government shall not transfer scheme related funds to any other bank account, except for actual payments under PMAY-G. The funds shall also not be diverted to Fixed Deposits/Flexi-Account/Multi-option Deposit Account/Corporate Liquid Term Deposit (CLTD) Account etc. In case of shortfall in State Share corresponding amount of Central Share will be deducted from the 2<sup>nd</sup> instalment. The Factum of release of these funds must be registered in the Public Financial Management System (PFMS) through updation in TRSY02 report. It may be ensured that the same is also reflected on Awaas Soft.*

5. Meanwhile the Government have made provision in BE/Re-appropriation 2022-23 under PMAY(G) Housing Grant under various Head of Account as follows:

6. Hence, the Commissioner of Rural Development and Panchayat Raj has therefore requested the Government to accord sanction for release of **Rs.200,23,71,000/- (Rupees Two Hundred Crore Twenty Three Lakh Seventy One Thousand only)** towards programme fund for Schedule Tribe category which includes Central and State share and to release the **Central Share (60%) of Rs. 120,14,22,600/- (Rupees One Hundred and Twenty Crore Fourteen Lakh Twenty Two Thousand Six Hundred only)** and the corresponding State matching Share (40%) of **Rs.80,09,48,400/- (Rupees Eighty Crore Nine Lakh Forty Eight Thousand Four Hundred only)** as 1<sup>st</sup> tranche of 1<sup>st</sup> Instalment excluding admin cost for Tamil Nadu for 2022-23.

7. The Government after careful examination of the proposal of the Commissioner of Rural Development and Panchayat Raj have decided to accord sanction for release of **Rs.200,23,71,000/- (Rupees Two Hundred Crore Twenty Three Lakh Seventy One Thousand only)** towards programme fund for Schedule Tribe category which includes Central and State share and to release the **Central Share (60%) of Rs. 120,14,22,600/- (Rupees One Hundred and Twenty Crore Fourteen Lakh Twenty Two Thousand Six Hundred only)** and the corresponding State matching Share (40%) of **Rs.80,09,48,400/- (Rupees Eighty Crore Nine Lakh Forty Eight Thousand Four Hundred only)** as 1<sup>st</sup> tranche of 1<sup>st</sup> Instalment excluding admin cost for Tamil Nadu for 2022-23.
