Order:

In the Government Order first read above, Clean Village Campaign was revived and re-introduced by the Government of Tamil Nadu during 2011-2012 with an allocation of Rs.1.55 crore for giving cash award of Rs.5 lakhs for 31 selected Village Panchayats, at the rate of one Village Panchayat from each District and issued detailed guidelines in this regard.

2. In the Government Order second read above 31 Village Panchayats were selected for Clean Village Campaign award for the year 2011-2012 and orders issued. Similarly in the G.O. third read above, 31 Village Panchayats were selected and orders issued for the Clean Village Campaign Award for the year 2012-2013.

3. In the letter fourth read above, the Director of Rural Development and Panchayat Raj has stated that Proposals received from Districts for Clean Village Campaign awards for the year 2013-2014 and 2014-2015 were scrutinized based on guidelines. He has recommended the following Village Panchayats for Clean Village Campaign Awards for the years 2013-2014 and 2014-2015 respectively and requested the Government to authorize the Director of Rural Development and Panchayat Raj to distribute the award money for each year of Rs.1.55 crore to

31 Village Panchayats each in the respective years from the amount already drawn.
