ORDER:

In the Letter read above, the Director of Rural Development and Panchayat Raj has stated that the Government of India have released a sum of Rs.225,65,00,000/- to the State Government towards first installment of Grant-in-aid as Central Share under Swachh Bharat Mission (Gramin) for the year 2018-19 as detailed below:

The Director of Rural Development and Panchayat Raj has further stated that Government of India's Sanction Order, the State shall ensure release / transfer of 60% Share along with State Matching Share to the implementing agencies within 60 days of its receipts. (60:40 ratio). As per the revised sharing pattern (60 : 40) under SBM(G) as against the release of 1st instalment of Central Share of Rs.225,65,00,000/- (60%) corresponding State Matching Share is work out Rs.150,43,33,000/- (40%) Total amount is Rs. 376,08,33,000/-.

3. The Director of Rural Development and Panchayat Raj has therefore requested the Government to release the 1st instalment of Central Share of Rs.225,65,00,000/- and also sanction the corresponding State Matching Share of Rs.150,43,33,000/- i.e. Total amount of Rs.376,08,33,000/- under SBM(G) for the year 2018-19.

4. The Government after careful examination, accord sanction for release of an amount of 376,08,33,000/- (Rupees Three hundred and seventy six crore eight lakh and thirty three thousand only) [Central Share of Rs.225,65,00,000/- (60%)] + State Matching Share of Rs.150,43,33,000/- (40%) towards the 1st instalment of grants-in-aid under Swachh Bharat Mission(Gramin) for the year 2018-19.

5. The expenditure sanctioned in para 4 above shall be debited under the following heads of account :

6. Necessary additional funds of Rs.4,29,64,000/- will be provided under the head of account "2215-02-794 UA 09 03 in RE/FMA 2018-2019. Pending provision of such funds, in RE/FMA 2018-2019, the Director of Rural Development and Panchayat Raj is authorized to draw and disburse the amount sanctioned in paragraph 4 above to all Collectors except Chennai / the Commissioner of Greater Chennai Corporation, the Director of Rural Development and Panchayat Raj should include the additional expenditure while sending the proposal to Government for inclusion in RE/FMA without fail. However this expenditure shall be brought to the notice of Legislature by specific inclusion in the Supplementary Estimates 2018-2019, the Director of Rural Development and Panchayat Raj is also requested to send necessary daft explanatory notes to Government in Finance(BG-1/ RD&PR) Department for inclusion of the Supplementary Estimates 2018-2019.
