Announcement - Announcement made by the Hon'ble Chief Minister under Rule 110 on the floor of Legislative Assembly on 03.07.2017 – Provision of additional street garbage collection bins in all the 12,524 Village Panchayats for effective implementation of the SWM activities in rural areas during the year 2017-18 – Orders issued.

ORDER:

In the G.O. first read above, the Government have issued detailed guidelines for establishment of Solid Waste Management System with recycling and waste disposal facilities in 2,000 Village Panchayats by converging MGNREGS Workers as "Thooimai kaavalars" at the rate of one worker per 150 households for door to door collection of waste, segregation and transporting to disposal pits etc.

2. In the G.O.s second and third read above, the Government have issued detailed guidelines for extending this scheme to another 7,000 Village Panchayats in Phase-II. For collection, segregation and safe disposal of waste, the basic infrastructure like tri-cycle / pushcart, Street Garbage Collection Bins and segregation and storage shed have been provided in 9,000 Village Panchayats.

3. In the G.O. fourth read above, the Government have issued detailed guidelines for extending the Solid Waste Management activities to the remaining 3,524 Village Panchayats in Phase III and also for providing additional infrastructure facilities in 9,000 Village Panchayats in Phase-I & II and thereby making Tamil Nadu as the First State in India converging MGNREGS for SWM activities in all the 12,524 Village Panchayats and introducing best practices in Rural cleanliness of the State.

4. The Hon'ble Chief Minister of Tamil Nadu has made the following announcement under Rule 110 on the Floor of Legislative Assembly on 3.7.2017.

“திடக்கழிவு மேலாண்மைத் திட்டம் அனைத்து கிராம ஊராட்சிகளிலும் வெற்றிகரமாக செயல்படுவதை மேம்படுத்தும் வகையிலும், கழிவுகள் அகற்றப்படும் முறைகளை நவீனப்படுத்தும் விதமாகவும், மாநகராட்சிகள், நகராட்சிகள் மற்றும் பேரூராட்சிகளுக்கு அருகாமையில் உள்ள கிராம ஊராட்சிகளுக்கும், மலைப் பிரதேசங்களில் அமைந்துள்ள கிராம ஊராட்சிகளுக்கும், அதிகமான மக்கள் தொகை கொண்ட பெரிய கிராம ஊராட்சிகளுக்கும் கூடுதல் உட்கட்டமைப்பு வசதிகளாக, தெருவில் வைக்கப்படும் குப்பைத் தொட்டிகள் 200 கோடி ரூபாய் மதிப்பீட்டிலும், மூன்று சக்கர மிதிவண்டிகள் / தள்ளு வண்டிகள் 100 கோடி ரூபாய் மதிப்பீட்டிலும், மற்றும் மின்கலம் மூலம் இயக்கப்படும் தள்ளு வண்டிகள் 200 கோடி ரூபாய் மதிப்பீட்டிலும் வழங்கப்படும். மொத்தத்தில் இத்திட்டத்திற்கென 500 கோடி ரூபாய் செலவிடப்படும்”.

5. In the letter sixth read above, the Director of Rural Development and Panchayat Raj has stated that the Joint Secretary, Ministry of Rural Development, Government of India in D.O. Letter No.M-11011/12/2017-FD, dated 08.09.2017 has stated that since “Fourteenth Finance Commission (FFC) Grants are being devolved to the Gram Panchayats (GPs) towards delivery of basic services including sanitation in the effort to improve sanitation in villages, it is suggested that State Governments may suitably impress upon the GPs to provide / install dustbins in every hamlet from the FFC funds”.

6. The Director of Rural Development and Panchayat Raj has also stated that as per the announcement made by Hon'ble Chief Minister of Tamil Nadu under Rule 110 on 3.7.2017, Street Garbage collection bins may be provided to all the 12,524 Village Panchayats at the rate of 1 per habitation and also additional two more Street Garbage collection bins to 290 Village Panchayats having more than 10,000 population. Therefore, 79,974 Street Garbage Collection Bins may be required in total.

7. The Director of Rural Development and Panchayat Raj has describe the procedure for Procurement of Street Garbage Collection Bins as follows :

“The Collectors may be directed to adopt technical specification for Street Garbage Collection Bins communicated by the Technical Unit of the Directorate of Rural Development & Panchayat Raj for this procurement. For uniformity, to ensure technical specifications and in view of the quantum involved, the procurement of Street Garbage Collection Bins may be done at district level by the District Collector, by scrupulously following the Tamil Nadu Tender Transparency Act, 1998 and Rules issued there under. The Project Director, DRDA shall be tender inviting authority and the District

Collector shall be tender accepting authority. After finalisation of tender, supply order shall be issued by the District Collector and agreement to be executed by the supplier for the supply of Street Garbage Collection Bins.”

8. The Director of Rural Development and Panchayat Raj has further stated that, Government of India has suggested to provide / install dustbins in every hamlet from the 14<sup>th</sup> Finance Commission grant. Further, the additional infrastructure now proposed is to strengthen civic maintenance capabilities of Village Panchayats. Therefore, the tentative fund requirement for providing additional 79,974 Street Garbage Collection bins will be approximately Rs.200 crore (79,974 x Rs.25,000 approximately) which may be met out from the 14<sup>th</sup> Finance Commission Grant released to Village Panchayats during 2017-18.

9. The Director of Rural Development and Panchayat Raj has therefore requested the Government to permit the Village Panchayats concerned to utilize the 14<sup>th</sup> Finance Commission grant of Rs.200 crore for the provision of additional street garbage collection bins in all the 12,524 Village Panchayats for effective implementation of the SWM activities in rural areas during the year 2017-18.

10. The Government after careful examination of the proposal of the Director of Rural Development and Panchayat Raj hereby accord permission to the Village Panchayats concerned to utilize the 14<sup>th</sup> Finance Commission grant of Rs.200 crore for the provision of additional street garbage collection bins in all the 12,524 Village Panchayats for effective implementation of the SWM activities in rural areas during the year 2017-18 with the following conditions:

- i) Ensure that the guidelines issued by the 14<sup>th</sup> State Finance Commission are complied.
- ii) Ensure the best price discovery and best quality of the product.
- iii) Should follow the Tamil Nadu Transparency in Tender Act for the purchase of the product by ensuring right procurement procedure.
- iv) No additional financial commitment will be entertained.
